

Basic Granny Hexi Motif



Abbreviations:

ch - chain
ch-sp - chain space
rep - repeat
rnd - round
sl st - slip stitch
st(s) - stitch(es)
tr - treble

How to make a basic granny hexagon:

Starting chain length: Ch 4
Appearance: Double-sided

Make a foundation chain of 4 sts (counts as 1tr and 1ch) and work all sts in rnd 1 into first ch st

Rnd 1: 2tr, 1ch (to form a corner), *3tr, 1ch, rep from * four more times, sl st into first st to join rnd.

Rnd 2: sl st into next 2 sts, sl st into 1ch-sp, ch3 (counts as a tr st here and throughout), 2tr into 1ch-sp, *2ch, 3tr into same 1ch-sp, 1ch, miss 3 sts, 3tr into next 1ch-sp, rep from * four times, 2ch, 3tr into same 1ch-sp, 1ch, join with a sl st into top of ch3.

Rnd 3: sl st into next 2 sts, sl st into 2ch-sp, ch3, (2tr, 2ch, 3tr) into same 2ch-sp, 1ch, miss 3 sts, 3tr in next 1ch-sp, 1ch, *(3tr, 2ch, 3tr) in 2ch-sp, 1ch, miss 3 sts, 3tr in next 1ch-sp, 1ch, rep from * four times, join with a sl st to top of ch3.

Rnd 4: sl st into next 2 sts, sl st into 2ch-sp, ch3, (2tr, 2ch, 3tr) into same 2ch-sp, 1ch, miss 3 sts, 3tr in next 1ch-sp, 1ch, *3tr in next 1ch-sp, 1ch, miss 3 sts, (3tr, 2ch, 3tr) in 2ch-sp, 1ch, miss 3 sts, 3tr in next 1ch-sp, 1ch, rep from * four times, 3tr in next 1ch sp, 1ch, join with a sl st to top of ch3.

Rnd 5: sl st into next 2 sts, sl st into 2ch-sp, ch3, (2tr, 2ch, 3tr) into same 2ch-sp, [1ch, miss 3 sts, 3tr in next 1ch-sp] twice, 1ch, *(3tr, 2ch, 3tr) into same 2ch-sp, [1ch, miss 3 sts, 3tr in next 1ch-sp] twice, 1ch, rep from * four times, join with a sl st to top of ch3.

To continue increasing the size of your hexagon motif, at start of each rnd sl st into next 2 sts, sl st into 2ch-sp, at each 2ch-sp corner, work (3tr, 2ch, 3tr) and at each 1ch-sp, work 3tr, 1ch.

As your motif grows in size, the edges will start to ruffle - don't panic! This is supposed to happen.

Top Tip - Add stitch markers to mark each corner of your hexagon motif! (Colour co-ordinate them to help turn the hexagon into a cardigan).



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Instructions checklist:

Rnd No.	Number of sts in rnd	Completed V
Rnd 1	18 tr sts + 6 ch sts	
Rnd 2	36 tr sts + 6 (1ch-sps) + 6 (2ch-sps)	
Rnd 3	54 tr sts + 12 (1ch-sps) + 6 (2ch-sps)	
Rnd 4	72 tr sts + 18 (1ch-sps) + 6 (2ch-sps)	
Rnd 5	90 tr sts + 24 (1ch-sps) + 6 (2ch-sps)	

Homework: Finish working first hexagon motif to your desired size. Make a second hexagon motif that matches the size of the first.
