Teams of 4 will conduct research, develop a thesis, then create museum displays on their findings. Each team member will be assigned a chapter from *Before Columbus* to focus on (additional research is encouraged). The objective is to think critically about the guiding question for each of the parts in *Before Columbus*. Teams will develop a thesis, then use evidence to support it. Theses and evidence will be on display in the form of a classroom museum. Teams will be evaluated according to the PBL rubrics on our website: sevies.org.
