What is copyright?

Copyright is a type of property that is founded on a person's creative skill and labour. Copyright is not a tangible thing.

Copyright protects the original form or way an idea or information is expressed, not the idea or information itself. The most common form of copyrights are writing, visual images, music and moving images.

Copyright provides an owner of a material with exclusive economic rights to do certain acts with that material. These rights include the right to copy and the right to communicate the material to public.

Copyright also provides authors and performers with non-economic rights, known as moral right of attribution and the right against false attribution.

Overview

The moment an idea or creative concept is documented on paper or electronically it is automatically protected by copyright in Australia.

The responsibility for copyright belongs to the Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Communications.

Copyright protects the original expression of ideas, but not the ideas themselves.

Common works protected by copyright include books, films, music, sound recordings, newspapers, magazines and artwork.

It also protects originally created typographical arrangements, databases, media broadcasts, computer programs and compositions of other people's work such as academic journals or CD compilations.

Copyright protection is provided under the Copyright Act 1968 and give the exclusive rights to license others in regard to copy the work, performing it in public, broadcasting it, publishing it and making an adaptation of the work.

Purpose of copyright

The primary purpose of copyright is to induce and reward authors, through the provision of property rights, to create new works and to make those works available to the public to enjoy. The theory is that by granting certain exclusive rights to creators that allow these creators to protect their creative works against theft, creators receive the benefit of economic reward and the public receives the benefit of the creative works that might not otherwise be created or disseminated. While the copyright law is intended to serve the purpose of enriching the general public through access to creative work, it is important to understand that the copyright law imposes no obligation upon creators to make their copyrighted works available. As a result, an unpublished work that is never distributed to the public receives the same copyright protections that a published work would receive.

Who is this policy for?

This copyright policy is addressed to all our clients, employees, users, authorities and any individual that in one way or another is related in any way to our PIS data center service.

Procedure for customers, users and the entire community

By using the services, you acknowledge that you and your users are responsible for compliance with this policy and agree to be bound by it. You are responsible for violations of this policy by any user who accesses the services through your account, including, without limitation, users to whom you provide services as a reseller. PIS does NOT intend to control or monitor any user's experience or the content of their online communications, however, PIS reserves the right to disconnect or terminate your access to services for use that violates (or may violate) the Policy or otherwise appear illegal. This policy is designed to protect PIS, services, customers, users and the Internet community from improper or illegal activities, to improve services and offerings.

network. PIS strictly prohibits the use of the Services for the transmission, distribution, retrieval or storage of any information, data and other material in violation of any applicable law or regulation (including, where applicable, any tariff or treaty). This prohibition includes, but is not limited to, the use or transmission of data protected by copyrights, trademarks, trade secrets, patents or other intellectual property rights without proper authorization and the transmission of any material that constitutes an illegal threat, infringes export control laws, or is obscene, defamatory, or otherwise illegal.

An example of illegal conduct is the infringement of intellectual property rights or other proprietary rights, including but not limited to material protected by copyright, trademark, patent, trade secret, or other intellectual property right. Infringement may result from the unauthorized copying, distribution, and/or publication of images, logos, software, articles, musical works, and videos.

How does the company deal with copyright infringement?

Generally, PIS will attempt to notify the customer or user of any activity that violates this Policy and request that the user cease such activity; however, in cases where the operation of PIS is threatened or in cases involving suspected fraud in connection with the use of the services, harassment or copyright infringement, the company reserves the right to suspend or cancel the services or the user's access to the services are notification.

In the event Company becomes aware that such material may violate the Terms and/or expose Company to civil or criminal liability, including but not limited to under copyright law, Company reserves the right to right to block access to such material and to suspend or terminate access by any user who creates, stores, copies or communicates such material, including any user whom the company is aware of as the customer or user having engaged in any of the previous activities several times.

PIS has NO obligation, to monitor or surveil the activity that occurs using the services and will have no liability to any party, including a client and user, for any violation of this policy.
