## **Overview of Navcharitable Social Help Foundation:**

Navcharitable Social Help Foundation was formed in the year 2022 by some rural background intellectuals by the aim of connecting the rural community with the main streamlining of the development and the establishment of the happy and prosperous society because they had seen the lacks and survive the rural life, how a rural talent suffer from better opportunity with lack of knowledge and resources. The organization was registered under the section 8 of the company Act 2013. Foundation is doing effort on the basis of the people participation in the rural areas of Bihar, Jharkhand and Uttar Pradesh from the last 3 years by the aim of integrated rural development have to take the long term thinking of the successive dreams with learning by doing from initial phase to up till now. In the first phase there was a help done with the developmental activity of Harvest Plus to spread the extension work in 2022 by the concern organization in the working areas. In review of the first phase it was found that there is a lack of knowledge, people organization and skilled leadership in the rural areas. So, the work was started in 2 villages Kharhatanr of Simri block and Chaki village of Chaki block of Buxar District, Bihar by the help of Volunteers in 2023 by the aim of overall rural development to reduce loop wholes. In the second review in the year 2024 it was found that there is lack of women and child participation in the organizational programs and have to pay more attention towards the women and children participation the work extension were done in 5 other villages of the Simari block. Similarly, in the year 2024 youth advocates were prepared for the youth advocacy to reducing the gaps in the government programs. There was a presence and well-structured help done by the organization on the state, national. In the present phase 2025 Foundation is doing efforts already in 50 villages in 10 blocks of Bihar, Jharkhand and Uttar Pradesh. Now we are working on Carbon Farming and natural farming with an NGO network and preparing the community as a watch dog for its effective implementation by helping the administration for its well implementation among the rural community in Bihar, Jharkhand and Uttar Pradesh of India.

### **Vision:**

To establish self-sufficient and empowered rural communities by promoting skilled individual and strong group based on the concept of values of human welfare, democracy and global unity.

### **Mission:**

To achieve our goal we ensure our active participation in the healthy competition of time bound, economic, result oriented and transparent programs by positive thinking with optimum utilization

of available resources and facilities. Then only we can learn and respect our heritage and can save it and build it progressive. This is indispensable for us by knowing, believing and doing sincerely. This is only good for us and this is Navcharitable Social Help Foundation.

- Strengthening the role of women's participation in rural development and focus on gender equality with farm, nonfarm, Agri allied and livelihood activities.
- Improvement in reproductive and child health care services through "Nirogi Nari Centre"
- Promote women centered micro enterprises and skilled entrepreneurship development
- To lift up agriculture for economic development in rural as well as urban areas

**Our Strategy: the way we work-**

- Promote women & child participation in the development intervention of Navcharitable Social Help Foundation
- Collaboration and networking with likeminded NGOs & GOs of common issues of concern
- Collaborate with other network s and peoples movements of district and state level initiatives
- Create awareness among the community to better accessibility of the government program and stream lining of local self governance
- Work towards holistic development of women, adolescent, children and Farmers
- To initiate collective efforts in the community for better usages and community based management of natural resources by the skilled individual.

- To promote women SHGs program and provide vocational training program for Farm and None -Farm sectors to increase the self-employment or establishment of the self – entrepreneurship.
- To promote a sub-divisional resource centre cum data bank for the community to provide the research documentation and capacity building initiative of people’s organization for its To Promote rural leadership including women and youths for support people based initiative, build up capacities to strengthen people’s based institution in rural areas
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- To promote a sub-divisional resource centre cum data bank for the community to provide the research documentation and capacity building initiative of people’s organization for its sustainability.

### **Organizational Norms – the spirit of work**

We have certain norms placed for day-to-day functioning.

- **Working Culture:** Navcharitable Social Help Foundation lay emphasis on time bound, Transparent and result oriented working culture
- **Team Work:** Navcharitable Social Help Foundation gives weight age to team work with institutional behavior and personal dignity.

### **Working Area of Navcharitable Social Help Foundation:**

Navcharitable Social Help Foundation is currently working in 5 villages comprising 3 BLOCKS and 3 Districts of Bihar, Jharkhand, West Bengal and Uttar Pradesh. All the villages were divided into 2 clusters and a cluster office positioned in the village center of the cluster and from this year the concern organization has started its work in 2 villages of Sahpur Block of Bhojpur District in Bihar.

### **Core Program:**

This is the program run by Navcharitable Social Help Foundation without any outside support. The focus is health, education and IGP through people participation. Throughout this we are targeting children, student, executive's old parents, widow and disabled of the BPL families and have implemented the Corona virus awareness campaign through the lamp enlightening by the help of the local administration and supervision of 10 Hand Wash Units. Our field staff done the work for the local Corona Vaccinations booth of the working areas in vaccination to the adage group of 18 plus years in 2 villages by the staff of the concern organization, around 15 Youth volunteers and NSHF representatives helped in the Corona vaccination and food packet distribution campaign.



### **Village Management Committee (VMC) Meeting:**

In the whole year total 30 VMC meetings had been organized in which the committee discussed about the various issues of the villages related to the over all development of the villages. The Laisoning among the PRI and the villagers is come up strong through the VMC in the working areas. In the year there were 2 SHGs followed up by the Cluster In charges and strengthened the saving capacity of rural poor and marginalized community.



### **Community Cleanliness:**

It is the program in which village volunteers clean the common meeting places, Community hall, Schools and hand pumps on the date of Village Management Committee meetings which symbolically amplifies the message for the cleanliness of their village. This encourages the people to maintain village cleanliness and improve health and hygiene among the 600 villagers.



### **Formation of Navcharitable SHGs as a Nodal SHGs:**

Initially, The people of NS working areas were sell their agriculture product in the local vendors on the very low prices but the interference of the Foundation worker they guided and started to sell their products in the Mandi on the market rate then privet money lender prohibited them for lending. After this, there are made self – help group but they had to face loaning problem in the banks so, the networking of SHGs has been established the Navcharitable SHGs as Nodal SHGs as a mini bank of the people. This is the main concept behind the establishment of Navcharitable SHGs.

The first step is to be member and form an SHG who selects their leaders called village leaders. The village leaders select cluster leaders and cluster leaders again select Program

Management Committee (PMC) leaders and the president of PMC becomes one of the board members. PMC ensures the program implementation in the villages.



### **Our key Programs:**

#### **Independence Day and Republic Day Celebration:**

Foundation representative celebrated Independence Day and Republic with the children of Non Formal Education Centre runs in the slums area of the villages. The Tiranga Flag hosted with 1200 children and remembered the sacrifice of our generation to get Independence and become republic India. After that some sweets distributed to the children and take vow to protect the country and labor hard for the future growth of the rural family.



#### **Health Awareness Camps:**

We organized 2 health camps in 2 different Villages. In this camp the Doctor tracked out 30 RTI and STI problems and 18 patients got free medicines and doctor advice. Target group non-school going youths were reached out with 5 different messages such as HIV/AIDS, RTI/STI, and Gender with men role, Sex & sexuality, Changes during Adolescent age. Trainings were provided to 30 Peer Educators and menstrual kit outlet holders also.



### **Our SHG program:**

Since the Foundation started work on SHG promotion and Development women farmers and poor families were in difficult conditions. Farmers were debt at neck and the lands and animals were in possession of Landers. Poor families were completely depended on farming. Owing to organizations efforts SHG was formed in those areas. Through SHG they started micro savings and micro credit. Gradually the poor individuals gain strength as a part of a group, reduces transaction cost for both Lenders and borrowers, women come out towards the empowerment. Due to Navcharitable efforts 20 families are working in income generation activities with total 2 SHGs.



Presently organization has 2 SHGs groups in 2 cluster, trying to avail the better economic status and income generations other than agriculture. SHG require several essential services that can be provided neither by individual SHG themselves nor are available on the market at a scale needed by the SHG. Most of these services are initially provided by the promoter organization but this is not sustainable. Neither since providing these services to the poor activity nor among the core competency of the promoter organization So there is strong need to make the Nodal SHGs for the economical strengthening and livelihood generation program.

Navcharitable is won supporting in the SHG program through training and capacity enhancement of beneficiaries to achieve the goals. BO trainings were given to enhance the

capacities of SHG member so that they can put their supportive role in the development of rural society and to generate the new options for livelihood.

**National Environment Awareness Campaign:**

Sansthan organized meetings in 3 different villages, 2 rally programs in 2 different villages and community cleanliness program in 2 villages through National Environment Awareness Campaign. The total people participation 105 and 2 school and non school going children participated in this National Environment Awareness Campaign. In this program the community done the sanitation and cleanliness at public places like as Hand pumps, water tanks and community halls and Places.

### **Human Resource: The Strength -**

#### **The Core Group:**

The core body combination of Director, Chief Functionary, Program Officer, Administrative officer, Accounts Officer, Office assistant General, Office Assistant Program and Office Assistant Account is an internal vigilant group keeps eye on all the programs and activities. There are 2 full time workers providing their services in the development of our targeted population. Our **Physical Resources** includes a library in its head office, which is full of large number of study materials and training modules and tool kits. In the IT age we have equipped with computer, printer and broad band Internet facilities also.



### **Volunteers – our plus position:**

We recognize all the 3 leaders of SHGs as volunteers who help in family contact, community cleanliness, organizing meetings and lobbying for better societal harmony. Other than them there are 20 Peer Educators and Animators who are spreading Vulnerable Diseases, community health monitoring related information in their villages.
