17th Annual Axe Taekwon-Do Tournament Invitation - April 11, 2026

You are cordially invited to attend the 17th Annual Axe Taekwon-Do, USTF sanctioned tournament, taking place on April 11, 2026, in Bellevue, Nebraska. This exciting event will be hosted at the Offutt Air Force Base Youth Center (Building 5085, 25th Street & Hruska Blvd), bringing together other USTF schools from several states for a full day of competition.

Registration begins at 8:00 a.m., with the competition running from 9:00 a.m. through 4:00 p.m. Participants are encouraged to pre-register, with a cost of \$45 per student. This fee includes entry into patterns, sparring, and team breaking divisions. Registration at the door will be available for \$55.



Team breaking will consist of three members per team and is open to all students ranked yellow belt and above. Required techniques include a downward knife hand strike, side piercing kick (modified is allowed), and turning kick. Competitors will use plastic boards for all breaking events: UMAB (green-black) boards for hand techniques, and PNP (tan-white) boards for foot techniques. Please note that the black PNP boards are not permitted for this competition.

This tournament continues to be a highlight for Axe Taekwon-Do within the USTF, offering students the opportunity to test their skills, build experience in competition as a competitor, and referee. Remember all students have varying requirements to be promotion eligible for participating in USTF tournaments as competitors and officials. USTF Ongoing Review of the Testing Syllabus and Requirements - Submitted by Grand Master Sereff, USTF Test Director and USTF Administrator

The United States Taekwon-Do Federation (USTF) Testing Syllabus for 1st Dan through 7th Dan Master Instructor contains a wealth of information designed to guide Black Belts through each stage of advancement. With so much valuable material included, leadership encourages a monthly review of the Syllabus to ensure members remain aligned with the standards established by our Founder, **Sr. Grand Master Charles E. Sereff**.

Our USTF Technical Director, **Grand Master Mike Winegar**, had a profound influence on the development and structure of this project. Today, he continues to support the growth and technical excellence of members by teaching the USTF Technical Course, reinforcing the high standards expected throughout the organization.

For Black Belts holding the rank of IV Dan within the USTF, active tournament involvement remains a key requirement. If you have not recently worked or participated in a tournament, please refer to the official Syllabus. Working at least three USTF tournaments prior to grading is required.

For members located in areas without sufficient numbers to host tournaments, alternatives such as attending a USTF Referee Course refresher or organizing in-house tournament events are encouraged to maintain and sharpen referee skills. For I, II, and III Dan members, tournament participation is also required as part of rank progression. As always, there may be exceptions based on individual circumstances, and instructors are available to provide guidance where needed.

Community Service continues to play a vital role in Black Belt development. Several years ago, **Sr. Grand Master Sereff** adjusted the former Thesis requirement to focus on Community Service. Many members already exceed the minimum expectation of 20 service hours annually. Contributing positively to our communities reflects the true spirit of Taekwon-Do and strengthens both our local impact and organizational unity.
