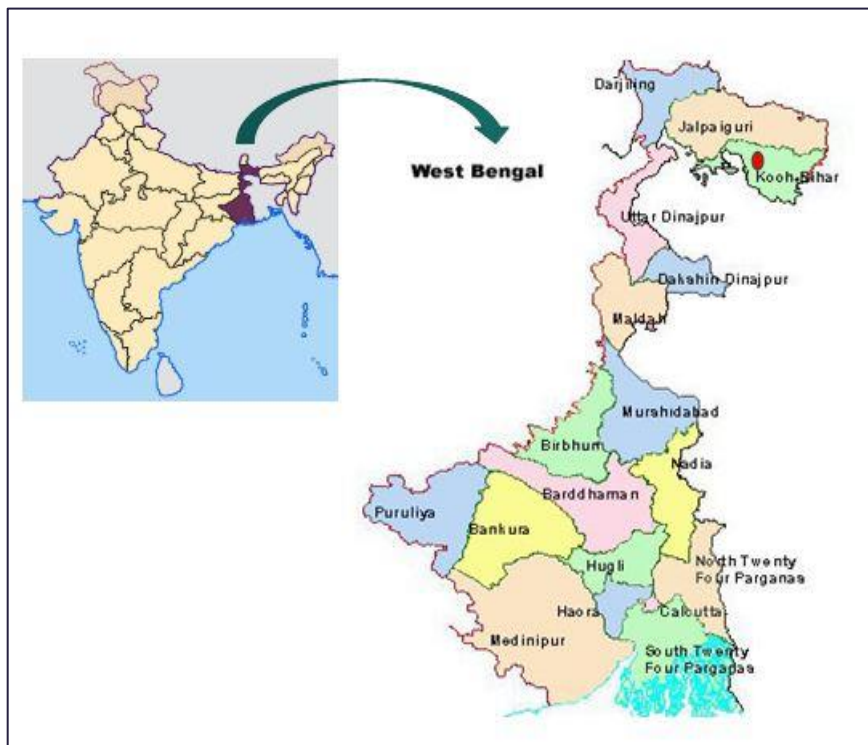

Secretary's Report

**[Report presented in 1st Annual General Meeting,
2014-15 dated 04.04.2015]**



Dear Members,

It is my pleasure to present the Secretary's Report of VEC Trust in its 1st Annual General Meeting. We have begun our journey shaking out our initial inertia. The dream of our President and honourable founder members has turned into reality while we registered our trust with Government on 8th August 2014, and outlined the vision, mission and goals of the Trust. We have also successfully established our functional structure, and able to take up roles and responsibilities in the concerned areas.

We have put our effort in each area of our activities. To build capacity of the local farmers, *VECT Mushroom Cultivation Training Centre* has been established at the village Gunnath and one workshop was organised demonstrating oyster mushroom cultivation process. To provide support to rural poor, we organised one cloth donation camp at the village Rautora for 50 poor beneficiaries. A picnic party on 25th December, 2014 was also organised for 20 children belong to underprivileged community of Joypura village, Dantan, Paschim Midnapore. These children were also given a physical training for one month and made aware of health and hygiene practices in daily life.

Annual Sports Meet 2014 is organised at the village Rautora comprising 20 sports events where 100 young children and youths participated. Winners are awarded. To promote tribal culture, one Santali dance program was organised at this village where 50 Santal artists participated.

I as a secretary of the trust has undertaken a research work on inter-state migratory agricultural laborers of Paschim Medinipur districts jointly with Mr. B. C. Das. The research work is being continued till date. Members are requested to note that Mr. Shibaprasad Mandal of Gunnath village has been given a financial aid as seed money to start up a leaf-plate manufacturing unit. To expand our activities promoting organic farming and employment generation, we have planned to set up one organic agriculture farm at the Rautora village.

Last but not the least, we extend our special thanks to the villagers of Rautora and local administration for their immense support to conducting the programs.

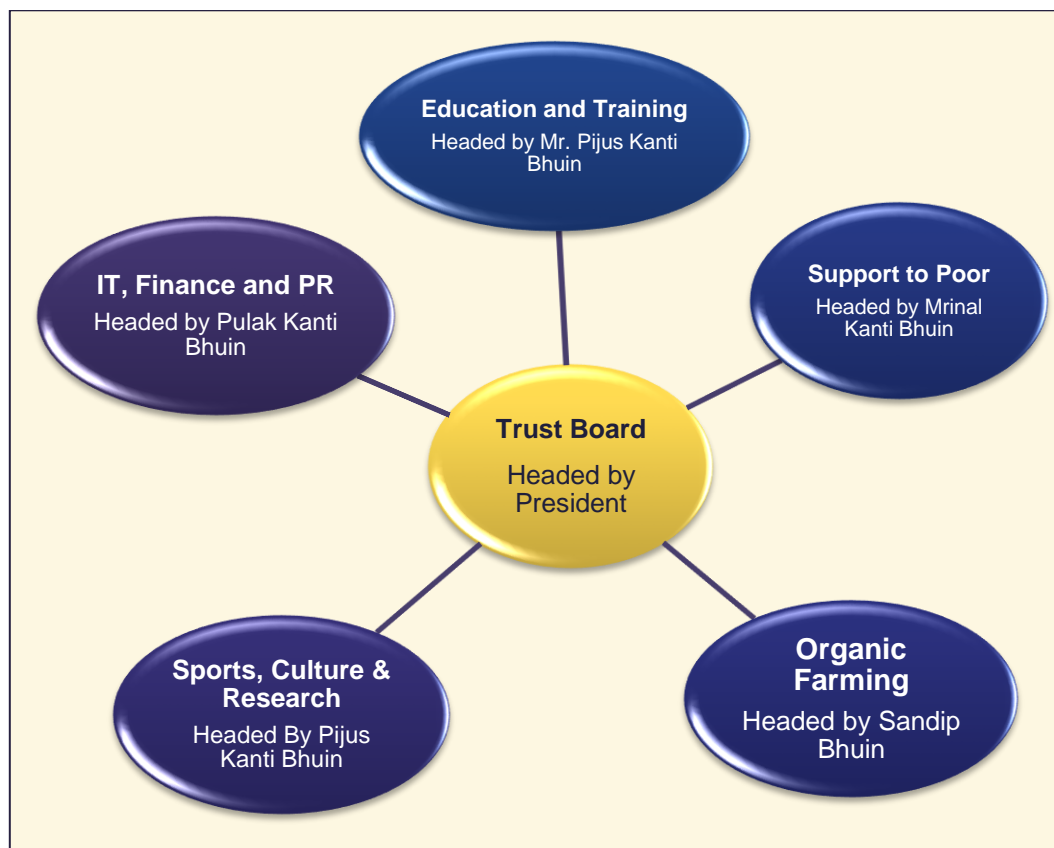

The objectives of the Trust would be undertaken on an annual basis and the entire team would be committed to achieve the objectives within the due timeframe. Primary responsibilities of the functioning of the Trust relies on founder members of the trust. A strong coordination, cooperation and synergy among the trustees has translated the functionaries into a powerful team. A separate team of activists are formed while any functional activity undertaken up by the board in a project mission mode. The control system lies with the board and it believes in team work.

Amid the financial crunch, the trust members and its support team has relentlessly keep on working to achieve the mission and goals. Initially, trustees rely on personal monetary donations and non-financial help from anybody owing to its endeavors.

Activities and Achievements

Education, Training and Capacity Building

VECT Mushroom Cultivation Training Centre: A mushroom cultivation training centre has been established at the village *Gunnath* to provide basic knowledge of scientific knowhow and hands-on experience to local farmers and housewives regarding the oyster Mushroom cultivation at their home during the winter season and sell them to local market in a profit. One workshop was organized on 10 September 2014 to educate 10 local farmers demonstrating how to cultivate the mushroom.

Support to deprived and underprivileged

Donation of clothes: 50 Poor and downtrodden women of the village Rautora of Bankura District are distributed clothes during the Diwali festival.



Picnic for poor children: 20 children of underprivileged family of *Dantan* village of West Midnapore district are taken to a local garden in a picnic party on 25th December, 2014. Children celebrated the day by cooking serving food and playing.

Promoting Ethnic and Tribal Culture

Santali Dance: *Santhal*, a local scheduled tribe, inherits a rich culture in music, dance, wall-art, food and festivals. We invited a local Santali troop from the village *Mahishdobra* to perform a musical dance program at the village *Raotora* in the eve of Diwali festival. Around 40 artists perform the dance program. Trust bears all the expenses of the troop and their family members including the diner.



Sustainable Agriculture

Member agree to develop a comprehensive plan for setting up an organic agricultural farm at the village Rautora to produce vermicompost, vegetables and fruit to promote organic agriculture among the local farmers, generate employment among local daily wage workers and serve local needy catering the produce free of costs. A work team would be formed to conduct feasibility study of the possible location, crops and irrigation facility.

Sports, Yoga and Meditation

Physical training: A Physical training camp was organized for a month during 15 October to 15 November 2014 at Joypura village of Dantan block enrolling 20 children belong to poor and underprivileged families. Children practice every day free-hand gymnastic, exercise and Kabaddi under the guidance and coaching of Mr. P.K. Bhui. Children are also explained the benefits of cleanliness and healthy practices in their daily life.

Annual sports meet

VEC Trust organizes Annual Sports Meet at Rautora village on 1st November 2014 encompassing 20 sports events among the school students (class I to class VIII). A sports committee of 10 local village members was formed headed by Mr. Sunil Mandal to organize the events successfully. Mr. P.K. Bhui anchored the program. A prize distribution ceremony was organized on 5th November and winners are awarded.



Research Works

Research on Interstate Migratory Labourers: Mr. P. K. Bhui along with Mr. Badal Chandra Das, Assistant Professor, Bhattar College, Dantan has undertaken a research work on migratory agricultural laborers using of Paschim Medinipur districts of West Bengal who travel every day to different places of Balasore district of the state Orissa. The objective of the study

is to identify the issues of livelihood regarding income and savings, family management, work-environment, health, support system using focus group methodology.

Financial Support to Social Entrepreneur

Mr. Shibaprasad Mandal of Gunnath village is provided a financial aid to set up leaf-plate manufacturing unit at his residential house. The business proposal of Mr. Mandal has been approved by the Board and he is given a financial assistance of Rs. 15000/- in February, 2015 as seed money to start-up the manufacturing unit of leaf plate using Sal leaves. The leaf plates are eco-friendly and green practice of serving foods.

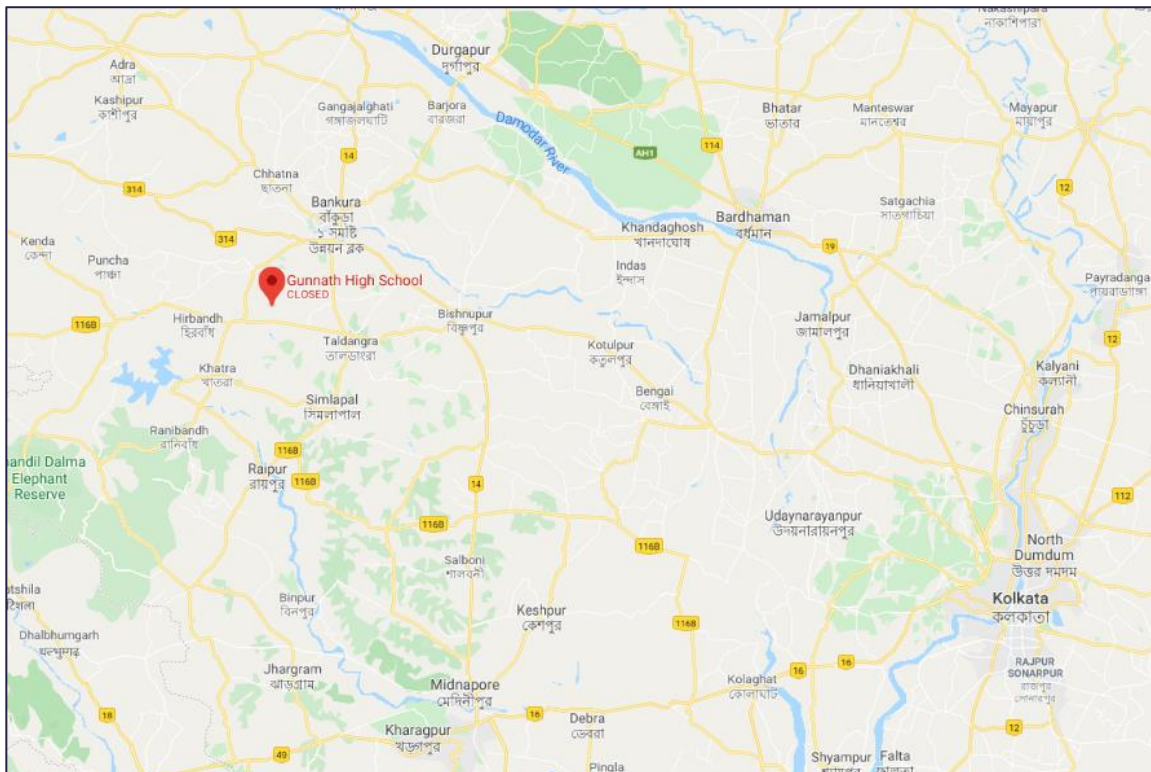
