Getting Started Prior to Connection with a Case Manager

You are being added to a waitlist to be connected to a housing case manager. A housing case manager will help you work on finding permanent and stable housing. Due to the high demand for housing case management in our area, it may take around 6 months for you to be connected. Here are some steps you can complete to prepare for housing case management and get started on your own:

Prepare for Your Case Manager to Contact You

Please make sure that the voicemail on your phone is set up and is not full. If you do not have a phone, please check your email or other form of contact frequently. If you do not have contact information, please check in regularly at CVOEO (255 South Champlain St, Burlington, VT) to see if you have been assigned to a case manager.

Collect Necessary Documents

Vital Documents:

- Social Security Cards for all household members
- Birth certificate for all household members
- Photo IDs for all adult members of the household

Proof of Income (if applicable):

- Paycheck stubs
- SSI/SSDI Letter

Places to Apply for Housing

If you have the necessary documents and want to get started, you can apply for housing at the following agencies. Please note that the waitlists for housing through these agencies are very long as there is very high demand for housing in our area. Approved applicants may wait several months to several years to be offered an apartment.

Burlington Housing Authority (BHA)
