There is Sabbath keeping that is true and another so-called sabbath keeping that is false. The true Bible Sabbath is the seventh day Sabbath.

This true Sabbath was established by God at Creation (*Genesis 2:2-3*) and is enshrined as the fourth of the Ten Commandments (*Exodus 20:8-11*). It is kept strictly from Friday at sunset to Saturday at sunset. "...from even unto even, shall ye celebrate your sabbath." (*Lev. 23:32*)

There is sufficient proof in the Bible which day must be observed as a holy and sanctified of the Lord. Any disregard of such a day, therefore, cannot be seen by heaven as ignorant on the part of man. The Bible clearly states that in the beginning God created the heavens and the earth and that He worked from the first to the sixth day and rested on the seventh day.

"Though sin has entered the world to mar His perfect work, God still gives to us the Sabbath as a witness that One omnipotent, infinite in goodness and mercy, created all things. Our heavenly Father desires through the observance of the Sabbath to preserve among men a knowledge of Himself. He desires that the Sabbath shall direct our minds to Him as the true and living God, and that through knowing Him we may have life and peace." (*6T 349.1*).

"Those who keep the Sabbath holy as the Lord has specified, reveal that they are His peculiar people, and that He who made the heavens and the earth is their God." (*5MR 85.2*).

"And the Lord says, "If thou turn away thy foot from the Sabbath, from doing thy pleasure on My holy day; and call the Sabbath a delight, the holy of the Lord, honorable; ... then shalt thou delight thyself in the Lord." (*Isaiah 58:13, 14*).
