Easter Service Lesson: "ALL HAIL THE RISEN KING!"

Theme: The Sacrificial Victory of Jesus for All People

Key Scripture:

*"And they sang a new song, saying, 'Worthy are you to take the scroll and to open its seals, for you were slain, and by your blood you ransomed people for God from **every tribe and language and people and nation.**'"*

— Revelation 5:9 (ESV)

I. The Price He Paid: The Cross

- **Isaiah 53:5** – *"But he was pierced for our transgressions..."*
- **John 19:30** – *"It is finished."*

Jesus didn't die to save only the descendants of Abraham — He died for the sins of the whole world. His cross wasn't the end; it was the *payment*.

Teaching Point: The blood of Jesus is not tribal. It's **global**. While some still reject Him — even deny His crucifixion — the empty tomb stands in defiance of every lie and unbelief.

II. The Power He Wields: The Resurrection

- **Matthew 28:6** – *"He is not here, for he has risen, as he said."*
- **Romans 1:4** – *"...declared to be the Son of God in power... by his resurrection from the dead."*

Resurrection was God's final stamp — *Paid in Full!* The same Jesus who was mocked, beaten, and buried is now **exalted** and alive forevermore.

Proclamation: Let every doubter, every deceiver, every denier take note — **the tomb is empty** and the throne is **occupied!**

III. The People He Purchased: Every Nation

- **Revelation 7:9** – *"a great multitude... from every nation..."*
- **John 10:16** – *"I have other sheep that are not of this fold..."*
- **Galatians 3:28** – *"There is neither Jew nor Greek... for you are all one in Christ Jesus."*

Jesus' sacrifice wasn't exclusive — it was **expansive**. Salvation was never meant to be limited to a single people group. His love embraces the **whole world**, even those who *currently* deny Him.

Exhortation: Preach Him until the nations hear. Love like He loved — without borders, without favoritism.

Conclusion: Crown Him With Many Crowns!

As the Church gathers on Easter, we shout with boldness:

"All hail the power of Jesus' name! Let angels prostrate fall!"

He is the King the world rejected, but Heaven has enthroned Him. He is the Lamb who was slain — and now the **Lion who reigns!**

Optional Additions:

- **Altar Call Invitation:** "He died for *you*. He rose for *you*. Will you now live for *Him*?"
- **Responsive Reading:** Psalm 24:7–10 – *"Lift up your heads, O gates!... that the King of glory may come in."*
- **Worship Song Pairing:** "Jesus Paid It All" or "Is He Worthy?" (Revelation 5-based)

Easter Sunday Prayer: "All Hail the Risen King"

Let us pray:

O Risen Lord Jesus Christ, our Savior and our King,

Today we stand in awe at the foot of an empty tomb and lift our eyes to Heaven's throne.

— victorious, glorious, alive forevermore!

We thank You for the blood You shed — not just for one nation or people, but for **every tribe, every tongue, every soul** that would call upon Your Name. You are the Lamb who was slain, and You have ransomed us to God by Your precious blood. We praise You, Jesus!

We humbly confess that we have all gone astray, but You, O Good Shepherd, laid down Your life so that we might be found, forgiven, and filled with resurrection life.

King Jesus, rule in our hearts today. Rule in this house. Rule in every nation, even those who do not yet know You — for Your Word declares that every knee *will* bow and every tongue *will* confess that You are **Lord** to the glory of God the Father.

Let Your resurrection power awaken dead hearts today. Let the Gospel go forth from this place like fire — unstoppable, undeniable, and unashamed.

And now, Lord, we ask:

Bless every man, woman, and child in this gathering. Strengthen the weary. Heal the broken. Restore the fallen. Fill the empty. Save the lost.

Make us a resurrection people — bold in faith, rooted in love, and aflame with holy joy. And when the world looks at us, may they see **You** — alive in us!

We ask all this in the mighty, matchless Name of the One who conquered death,

JESUS CHRIST, our Risen Lord!

And all God's people said—

AMEN.
