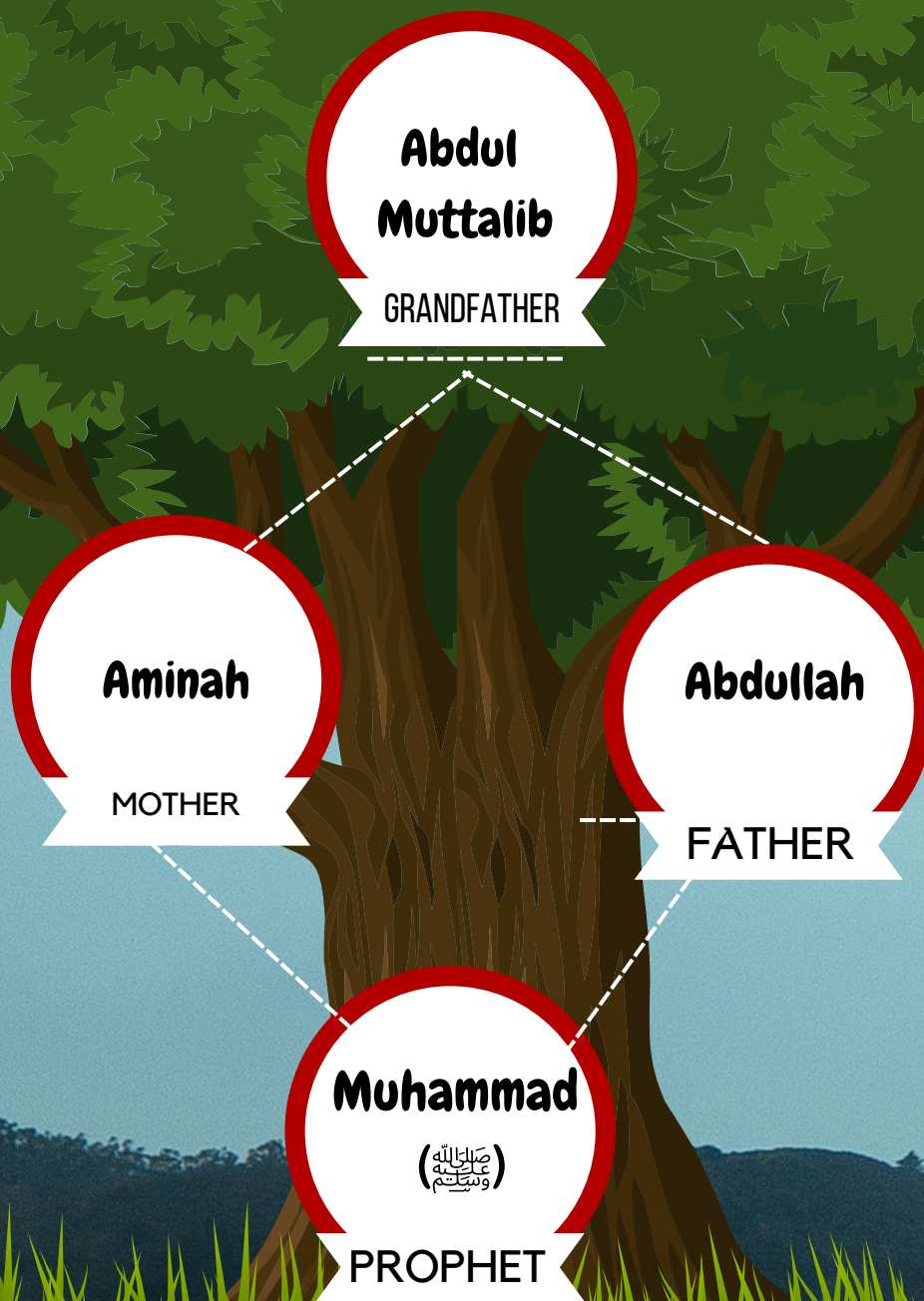

His father, Abdullah died when the prophet ﷺ was very young.

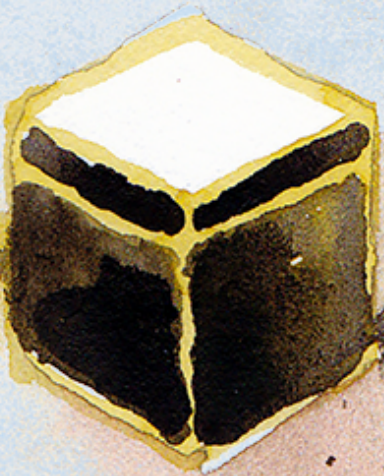
Some narration states it was 2 month's after his birth and some states his father died when his mother Aminah was pregnant.

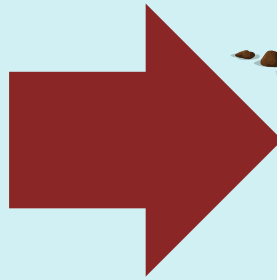
Prophet Muhammad ﷺ lost his parents when he was very young.

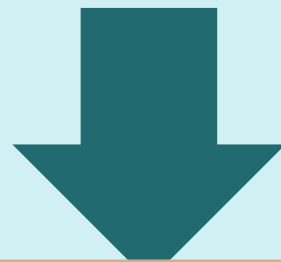

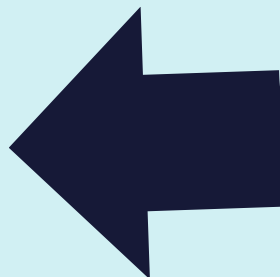

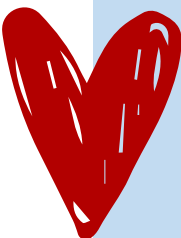
CARE OF GRANDFATHER

Sent out for suckling came back after 4 or 5 years, then mother died.

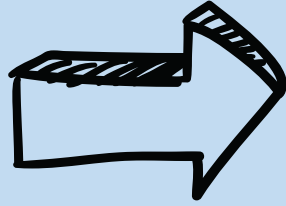
Was under the care of grandfather until he turned 8 years old then Grandfather died.

Later, his paternal uncle was the guardian.



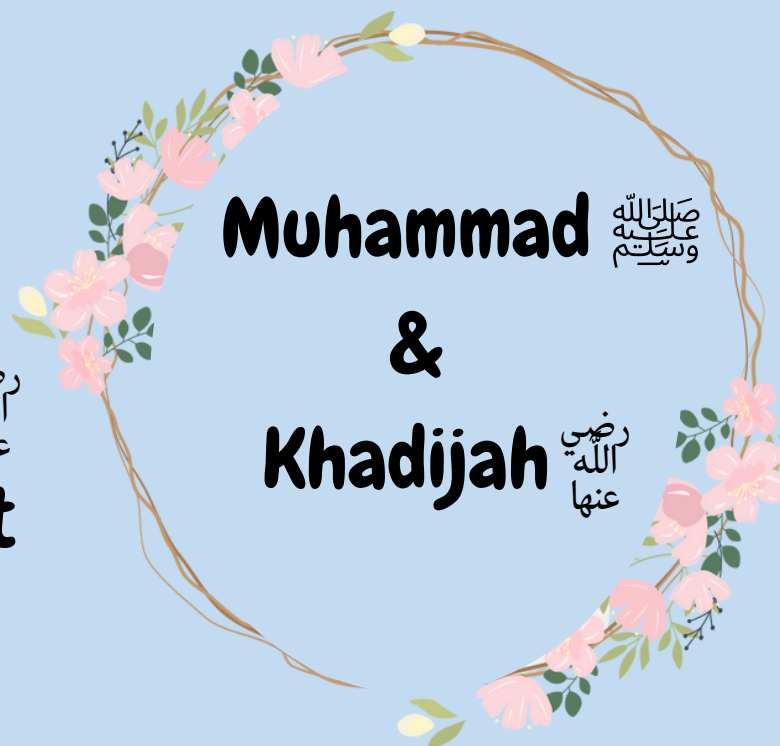
OCCUPATION:

When he ﷺ was nearly 40 years old, he used to reflect upon the beliefs in his community and used to go to the cave HIRA in Mount An Noor and used to be in seclusion there, meditating and devoting.

REVELATION OF THE HOLY QUR'AN



In Ramadan, he ﷺ was honoured With Prophethood and some verses Of the Qur'an was revealed to him ﷺ.

The Angel Jibreel (alaihi salam) came to him ﷺ and said, "Recite" thrice and each time his ﷺ response was "I cannot recite". Jibreel (alaihi salam) squeezed him for the third time and let go and said

"READ IN THE NAME OF YOUR LORD. WHO HAS CREATED (all that exists). HAS CREATED MAN FROM A CLOT. READ! AND YOUR LORD IS THE MOST GENEROUS."
(96:1-3)

He ﷺ repeated the verses and went home trembling with fear to his wife. She رضي الله عنها comforted him and reassured him that Allah won't leave him ﷺ.

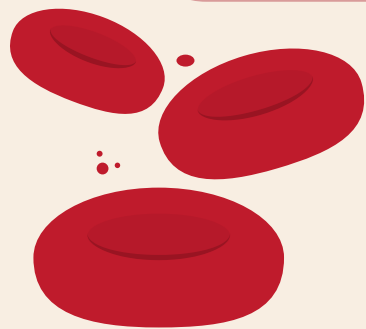
SPREADING ISLAM AFTER PROPHETHOOD

The first to accept Islam was his ﷺ wife, Khadijah. The call to Islam was secret in the first 3 years. Many started to accept Islam. There were more than 40 people who had accepted Islam. Meanwhile, the Prophet ﷺ used to receive revelation through Jibreel(alaihi salam) and teach it secretly to the new reverts.

What is Dawah?



Calling people to Allah is an important task and a glorious mission, because it means calling people to worship Allah alone. It means bringing them from darkness to the light, planting goodness in the place of evil and truth in the place of falsehood.

“Invite (mankind, O Muhammad) to the way of your Lord (i.e. Islam) with wisdom (i.e. with the Divine Revelation and the Quran) and fair preaching, and argue with them in a way that is better. Truly, your Lord knows best who has gone astray from His path, and He is the Best Aware of those who are guided.” [al-Nahl 16:125]

Reward for doing Dawah

Prophet (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) said to ‘Ali (may Allaah be pleased with him) when he sent him to Khaybar to call the Jews to Islam: “By Allaah, if Allaah were to guide one man through you, that would be better for you than having red camels [the best kind].”

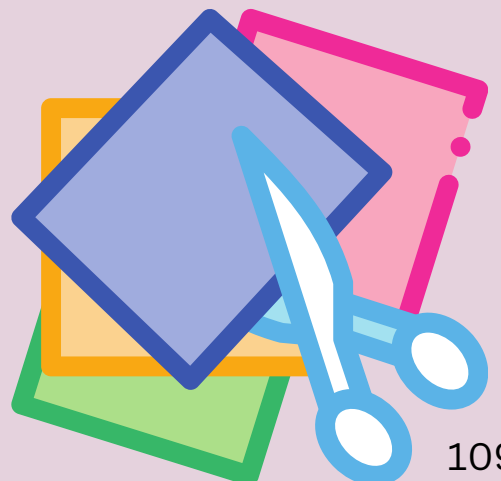

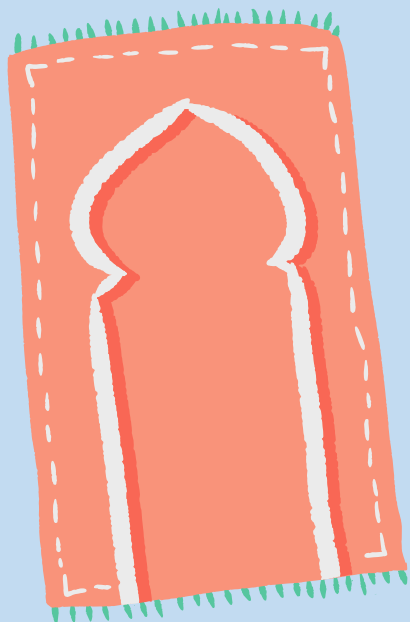
Prophet Muhammad ﷺ used to meet and teach the new converts the religion in privacy as the call to Islam was still running on individual and secret basis.

The Prophet ﷺ said, 'I was then brought a white beast which is called al-Buraq [from the Arabic word barq, meaning lightning], bigger than a donkey and smaller than a mule. Its stride was as long as the eye could reach'. [Muslim]

It is narrated by Anas (may Allah be pleased with him) that Buraq was, 'saddled and reined, but he shied from him "ﷺ". So Jibril [as] said to him; "Is it from Muhammad ﷺ that you do this? For nobody has ridden you who is more honourable to Allah than him!" He said, "Then he started sweating profusely". [At Tirmidhi]

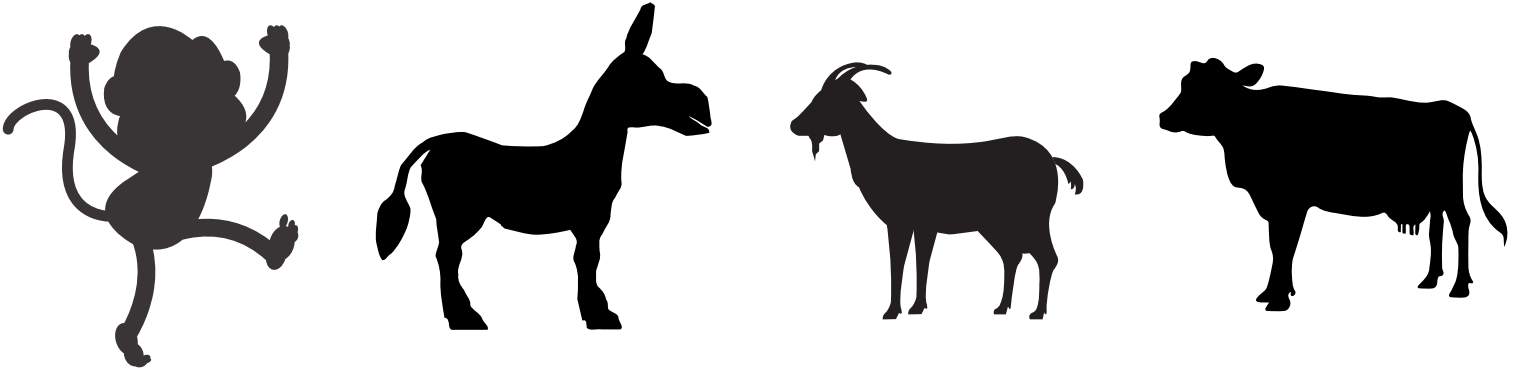
"Glorified (and Exalted) be He (Allah) (above all that (evil) they associate with Him), Who took His slave (Muhammad (blessings and peace of Allah be upon him)) for a journey by night from Al-Masjid-al-Haram (at Makkah) to the farthest mosque (in Jerusalem), the neighbourhood whereof We have blessed, in order that We might show him (Muhammad (blessings and peace of Allah be upon him)) of Our Ayat (proofs, evidences, lessons, signs, etc.). Verily, He is the All-Hearer, the All-Seer". [Surah Al-Isra'17:1]

The open call

Even though the call to Islam was secret, the people of Quraish came to know about the Call but they didn't paid attention to it because Prophet ﷺ wasn't talking about their gods or their religion. Later, he ﷺ received revelation from Allah to call people towards Islam openly so he ﷺ called his kinsmen towards Islam. His uncle Abu Talib supported him but his uncle Abu Lahab opposed him.

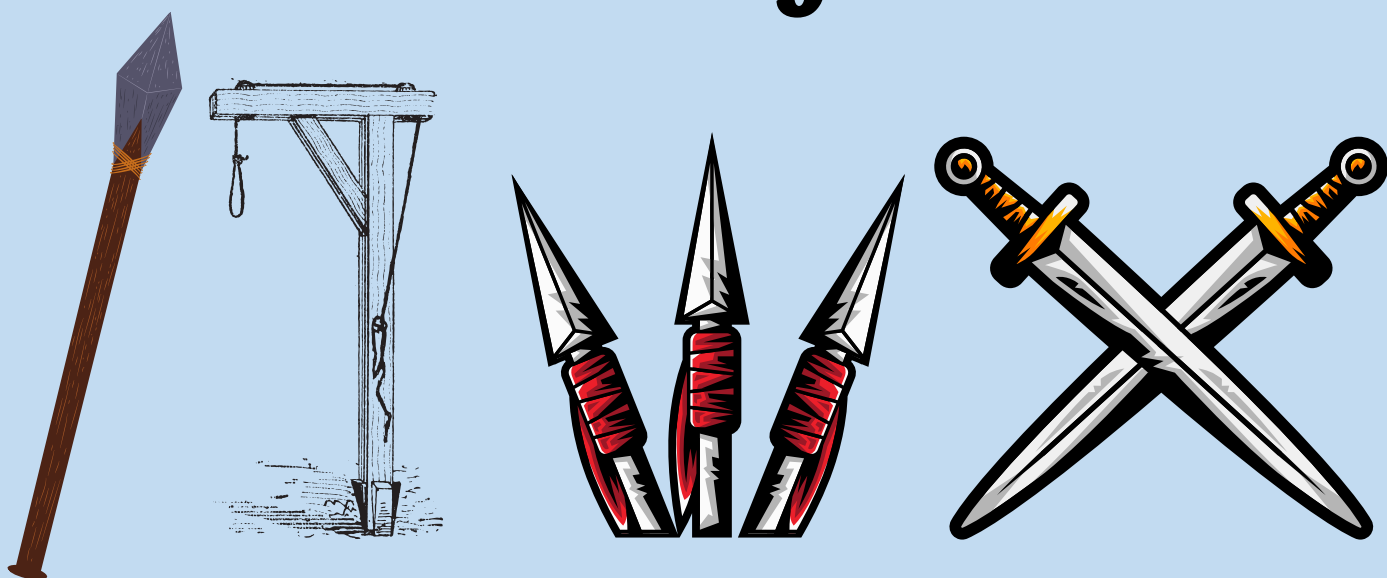
On Mount As Safa

One day, he ﷺ stood up on Mount As Safa and called his people towards Islam. Abu Lahab told "Perish you all the day! Have you summoned us for such a thing?"

Allah revealed Surah Lahab in response to this. He ﷺ called openly people to Islam and started to worship Allah in front of them (started to pray in ka'bah) and disproved their superstitious beliefs.

Many accepted islam and the idolators weren't happy with this. They started to call the Prophet ﷺ with awful names like magician, soothsayer, majnoon etc and were ridiculing, taunting him and the new converts with cheap manners. They tried all the ways to stop the preaching and stop people from accepting the truth.

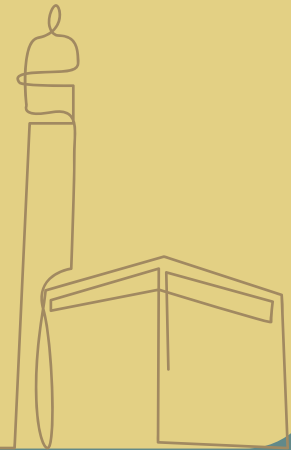
The strong faith



The new converts (may Allah be pleased with them all) were tortured severely but they were persistent upon Islam Alhamdulillah. They were ready to die but not leave Islam. Allah revealed the verse for them to migrate to Abyssinia. They were treated with good hospitality there.

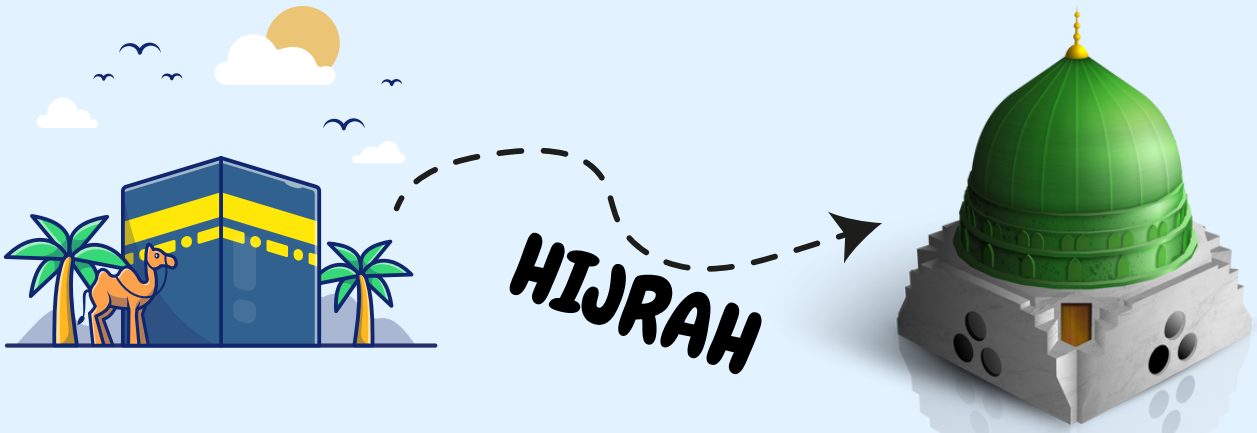

HIJRAH



He ﷺ migrated to Madina along with the new Muslims as they had more support there than in Makkah. This migration is called HIJRAH.

There, by the mercy of Allah, an Islamic State was established. Later, he ﷺ conquered Makkah after many years. He ﷺ endured many struggles in his life yet didn't give up teaching and spreading the deen of Allah.

His ﷺ death:

On the 12th of Rabi' ul Awwal, he ﷺ breathed his last breath in the house of our mother Aishah ^{رضي الله عنها}.

He ﷺ was 63 years and 4 days old when he ﷺ died.
