
SUPER HEROES

His master was very cruel, He would eat heavily and go to bed drunken.





Bilal i was dragged on the streets and he was chained with steel chains and was whipped. Bilal was so strong in Imaan that he always said "Allah is One, Allah is One"






They asked him to say good things about their idols but he replied

He was a warrior who always wanted to fight for the cause of Allah. Bilal (may Allah be pleased with him) participated in several wars with Prophet Muhammad




BECOMING A MUSLIM
