## How many Alphabet are there in Arabic?


There are scholarly differences about the total number of Alphabet in Arabic i.e if it's 28 or 29. This book sticks with the opinion that 29 Alphabet are there.

Let's get to know them!






This is ALIF. He's a single man who is tall and old. Since he's old, he doesn't have any sound on his own.



The next one is "Haa" who won't each much so he has no food in his tummy. "Haa" will look like his brother "Jeem" but without any dot in








The last brother is "Khaa" who loves to wear a hat always on his head. He also looks like his brothers but he has a dot above his head.






On their way to the park, they met with another twins "Seen" and "Sheen" who were also going to the park. They all went together.




When they reached the park, they found three other twins playing there. They all introduced themselves to each other and started to play.






Once there lived a farmer "Faa" who was poor and old. Since he's poor, he decided to meet the king to ask for some help. He was going to the Palace.

"Faa" was able to see the Palace from a distance and he was amazed so much and exclaimed "Wow"




Since "Faa" was walking for a long distance, he was so tired. After he reached the Palace, he was saying "Haa" because he was tired.
