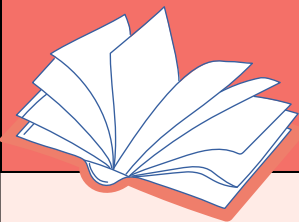


# Read, Relevance, Represent

Your GenAI output can be impressively fluent yet deeply flawed. Using these steps, ask yourself questions to assess your AI output before relying on it.

## READ

Ask: What exactly am I looking for?



- Carefully read – don't just skim, interrogate it line by line.
- Look out for tone and style, claims and evidence
- Phrases like "experts agree that..." or specific numbers and vague terms can be traps

### Assess

## RELEVANCE

Ask: Does this serve the actual purpose of my task?

- Compare the output to your prompt or task description. AI can write well but still wander off-topic
- Look out for generic answers that may not link to your instructions or specifics

## REPRESENT

Ask: Does this output represent me?



- The content must reflect your understanding, voice and values
- Remove foreign ideas and build on ideas you like
- Reflect on academic honesty, integrity, and be accountable
