Cookies may be used to:

We implement reasonable administrative, technical, and organizational safeguards designed to protect personal information from unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction.

However, no internet transmission or electronic storage system can be guaranteed to be completely secure.

## **Data Retention**

We retain personal information only as long as reasonably necessary for ministry operations, legal compliance, security purposes, recordkeeping, or fulfillment of the purposes described in this Privacy Policy.

## **Your Privacy Rights**

Depending on your jurisdiction, you may have rights regarding your personal information, including the right to:
