

America celebrates its 250th Anniversary in 2026 and your non-profit organization can be part of the celebration by helping the Oklahoma Native Plant Society (ONPS) plant 2 pounds of wildflower seeds in all 77 Oklahoma counties. A one (1) pound package of seeds will be provided by ONPS to one (1) or two (2) qualified non-profit, governmental or municipal entities (i.e. Master Gardener, Girl Scouts, Garden Club, etc.) per county to plant in a public space (i.e., park, courthouse, library or fairgrounds, etc.). The selected group(s) will receive a pound of native-to-Oklahoma wildflower seeds, that will bloom for extended periods and reseed, if allowed to mature. Your group will also receive instructions on when and how to plant in your public space and a sign that designates the area as a Pollinator Plot to Celebrate America 250 with Wildflowers! The deadline to apply is September 15th and seeds will be delivered in mid-October for planting before December 31, 2025. The seeds should cover 1,200 sq.ft. and begin blooming in mid-April or early May with an explosion of color in your public space that will attract pollinators, birds, and other wildlife with minimal care, once established.

According to the United State Department of Agriculture, Three-fourths of the world's flowering plants and about 35 percent of the world's food crops depend on animal pollinators to reproduce. That's one out of every three bites of food you eat. More than 3,500 species of native bees help increase crop yields. Some scientists estimate that one out of every three bites of food we eat exists because of animal pollinators like bees, butterflies and moths, birds and bats, and beetles and other insects. Increasing the wildflowers in all 77 counties can have a **BIG** impact on food for these important animals.
