

PAA PowerPoint and Presentation Activity - 15 marks

This short project has two purposes.

1. To give you a chance to demonstrate your ability to create an appropriately constructed slideshow in PowerPoint
2. It's an easier opportunity to begin practising presentation skills/

Task

- Create and present a slideshow that meets all the requirements listed below.

Required Elements

- The slide show must be 6 to 10 slides long
- Presentation time must be no less than 1:30 and no more than 3:00
- Of the 6-10 slides, it must contain a mix of the following layouts
 - Title (1 only)
 - Title and content (any #)
 - Two content (any #)
- Any design except blank
- Bullets must be animated but don't overdo it (less is more)
- Appropriate transitions between slides (e.g fade, wipe, etc.)
- Multiple images or clipart within the overall show
- Saved to your PAA folder, *FirstnameInitial_project_title* . Share the file with me.



Topic Ideas - examples

- All info must be accurate. Research as needed.
- Most topics are fine. It can be light in tone. E.g. your pet, hobbies, family history etc. However, this is a graded activity and should reflect that
- A timeline of any historical person, group or event (needs a bit of research but can be interesting for your audience)
- Who Am I? - slideshow that talks about yourself and uses your name like an acronym. Each letter is the basis of a slide for some aspect of who you are
- A topic suggested by you and approved by me - come with details

Advice

- KISS
- Recall the funny video you viewed. Steer clear of those common mistakes!
 - Avoid: Too much text, too many bullets, unnecessary/distracting animation, distracting sound, poor contrast, spelling mistakes (unforgivable!),
