Crystal-clear rivers, blue grottos, and impressive waterfalls. Flights to Campo Grande (CGR) and transfers to Bonito. Accommodation in the center of Bonito and in rural areas.



Monte Roraima

Flat-topped plateau with surreal landscapes and unique flora. Access from Boa Vista (BVB) and guided multi-day trekking. Accommodation in base camps and on the summit of the mountain.

Praia do Forno, Arraial do Cabo, RJ

Turquoise waters and abundant marine life. Access by trail or boat from Arraial do Cabo. Ideal for diving and snorkeling.



Canion do Xingó, Sergipe/Alagoas

Navigating the Brazilian "Grand Canyon". Catamaran tours and impressive landscapes.



Chapada dos Veadeiros, Goiás

Mystical landscapes and renewing energies. Trails, waterfalls, and unique rock formations.



Jericoacoara, Ceará

Dunes, lagoons, and an unforgettable sunset. Buggy rides, kitesurfing, and paradisiacal landscapes.

Destination 10: Domingos Martins, Espírito Santo - A Refuge of German Culture in the Mountains
