Eventually, he joins a desert caravan and meets an Englishman searching for an alchemist, which leads him to more discoveries. In the oasis of Al-Fayoum, Santiago meets Fatima and falls in love, but he knows he has to keep going if he wants to complete his quest. He finally meets the alchemist, who teaches him to listen to his heart and recognize the deep connection between all things. After many challenges, Santiago reaches the pyramids—only to find out the treasure was actually back where his journey began. He returns home, finds the treasure, and realizes that everything he experienced along the way was just as valuable as the gold itself.
