- We gather today to celebrate the most blessed event the world has ever known: the birth of our *Lord* and *Savior*, Jesus Christ.
- Our *Responsorial Psalm* today says, "All the ends of the earth have seen the <u>Saving Power</u> of God...!" (Ps 98)
- We all need a *Savior*... It's too easy to lose our way in life and become confused about our *Purpose in Life*.
- "Our purpose in life" of course, is to prepare our Soul for the next life—the Eternal Life."
- The *Eternal Life* is where all the "citizens of heaven" get to live in perfect *Peace*, *Harmony* and *Happiness*.
- This has never happened in this world because mankind wants to continually rely on his own Wisdom and Authority, rather than God's.
- You can't have perfect *Peace*, *Harmony* and *Happiness* if everyone in the world gets to determine what "TRUTH" is.
- For this reason, there can only be ONE TRUTH and that <u>TRUTH</u> must come from God—the Designer, Creator and Sustainer or our Lives.

- Our God is not a god of confusion. Confusion is of the Devil, and from it, comes hate, violence and chaos—whether it's in our souls—or in the world.
- It's only when people know what <u>TRUTH</u> is, that *Peace* and *Harmony* can reign in our *Soul*, in our *Family* and in our *Society*.
- That's why there must be one *Absolute Truth*, a *Truth* that cannot be refuted by the reasoning of mankind.
 - A <u>Truth</u> that comes from the very mouth of God!
 Enter, Jesus Christ, who was God on earth!¹
- St. John tells us in today's Gospel, "The Word became Flesh, and dwelt among us!" (Jn 1:1-18)
- No one saw God's face in the Old Testament. When God spoke it was from a burning bush, or a cloud, or in the wind.
- We heard the VOICE of God, the WORD of God, but never saw His face.
- But now, the "WORD" became "Flesh" and took on our Human Form so we could have a "living example" of what God expects
 ALL of His Children to become.

- As the Letter to the Hebrews says,
 - "God spoke in partial and various ways to our ancestors through the Prophets... but in these last days, He has spoken to us through the <u>Son</u>!" (Heb 1:1-6)
- Simply put, "We never really knew God until we met His Son..."
- God promised us that one day He would walk among us and teach us His Commands (Lev 26:12, Is. 54:13; Jn 6:45).
 - That's in *Leviticus* Ch. 26, *Isaiah* Ch. 54, and *John* Ch. 6.
- God gave us hundreds of *Prophecies* in the OT about His entrance into the world through the *Messiah*, the *Chosen One*, the *Christ*.
- We've been listening to these Prophecies over the last 4 weeks of Advent and we will hear more of them when <u>Lent</u> begins in February.
- **Jesus Christ** is the only figure in the history of the world to ever fulfill those prophecies.
- It wasn't *Buddha*. It wasn't *Confucius*. It wasn't *Krishna*. And it certainly wasn't *Muhammad* who came 600 years <u>after</u> Christ and even denied Jesus was Divine.

- Nope, Jesus is truly the Messiah, as <u>foretold</u> by God and <u>fulfilled</u> by Christ—
 - who then fulfilled his own prophecy by *predicting* his death—and then *rising* from it.
- If someone is going to tell you they know the path to <u>Eternal</u>
 <u>Life</u>, don't you think they should be able to prove it?
- Again, only Jesus Christ did this. What does this tell you about him?
- That's right! He was <u>God on earth</u> and as St. Paul tells *the*Colossians, "the visible image of the invisible God" (Col 1:15-18).
- Now, if you believe Jesus was God on earth, you cannot claim to be a "follower" of Christ in *one breath*, and then in *another breath*, disagree with what he has commanded us to do.
- **St. Augustine said,** "If you believe what you *like* in the Gospels, and *reject* what you don't like, it is not the Gospel you believe in, but yourself..."
- We all want Jesus as our *Savior* in life to take away our *Sins* and make our Soul feel good and whole again.

- But there's another side of us that doesn't want Jesus to be the <u>LORD</u> of our life whose <u>will</u> and <u>authority</u> we must obey.
- And the reason we don't want to do everything that Jesus commanded us to do...
 - you know like: love your enemies, forgive seventy times seven, do unto others as we'd have done unto us, be holy just as your Father in heaven is Holy..."
 - o ...is because that would mean we would have to change!
- I know what you're thinking... you're thinking, "God loves me just the way I am..."
 - That's true! But God also loves you too much to <u>leave</u> you that way!
- If we truly believe that Jesus is the *Savior* of our Life, that means we must also accept Him as the <u>LORD</u> of our Life and trust in *HIS* wisdom over our own.
 - This is why *Proverb 9* says, "Fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom..."

- God knows, it's too easy to lose our way in life when we start thinking that "we know better than God what's best for us."
- That's like children telling their parents they know what's best for them. And yet, that's what we do to God *all the time!*
- The first lesson in the Bible with Adam and Eve is that they wanted to become "god-like", without the help of God,
 - just like children want to be "adult-like" without the help of adults.
 - We know it doesn't work that way with our children, and it certainly doesn't work that way with God!
- My Christmas wish for you all in the coming year is that we will always seek Christ out with the same Enthusiasm and Joy that we seek him with at Christmas time...
 - ...that we renew our Baptismal promises to be a true disciple and follower of Christ, and obey <u>ALL</u> of his teachings and commands—not just the ones we pick and choose.

- History proves time and time again that when we ignore the wisdom of the Gospel, mankind will always find a <u>lesser</u> wisdom to live by.
- And if you don't believe that, just look at all the terrorism, confusion and anger going on around the world, and in own country!
- Come to Mass! Practice your Catholic Faith! Defend the only doctrine in the history of the world that contains the formula—
 - not only for World Peace—but for <u>Everlasting Peace</u>
 through the <u>Prince of Peace</u>—JESUS CHRIST!
