- We live in a time when <u>excellence</u> and <u>perfection</u> are much sought after when it comes to the things of this world.
- We see many people dieting and exercising working to have the "perfect body."
- But how many are working at having the "perfect Soul?"
- Other's seek academic excellence and pursue perfect grades in Math, Science, Social Studies, and Art. This is good!
- But how many seek excellence in <u>RELIGION</u> by really studying their <u>Catholic Faith</u> and understanding, and living by, all of our Lord's teachings?
- The central message of today's Readings is about TRANSFORMATION!
- "Abram" will be TRANSFORMED into "Abraham" when God fulfills His Promise to make him the "Father of many nations" (Gen 17:3-6).
- His Apostles will be transformed by realizing Jesus truly is Divine, and the Son of God!
- Jesus appears before his Apostles as "Dazzling White Light."

- Jesus literally "glowed" before the Apostles because he revealed to them his <u>SPIRITUAL</u> Body—the more <u>DIVINE</u> aspects of his nature.
- Jesus' Glorified Body is the same type of body <u>we</u> can expect when we die if we invite more and more of the <u>Supernatural</u> <u>Life</u> of Christ to live in us!
- Think of your favorite *Superhero* (mine is *Superman*.) Wouldn't it be cool to be just like them?
 - O And wouldn't it be cooler if we were able to become like them by eating something they gave us?
 - That's what Jesus is trying to do for us through the Holy Eucharist—instill HIS nature and being in us!
- People in Jesus' day had no clue what to expect after they died.
 They debated all the time what happened to the Soul after it left the body.
- Did they still look the same? Could they speak and listen? Did they retain all their memories and personalities?
- The answer is, YES!

- Despite our physical bodies being left behind, we still hold on to those things that make us—*US*, the *eternal* things of our being!
- Think about this... All the information computers store is done *electronically*.
- That means all of the audio, video and information we program into our computers—our LIFE, our Memories, the Information about our very being—lives DIGITALLY in a computer!
- In the same sense, our SOUL—which is the *Energy* and *Life-Force* of our Body—will also retain all the information and abilities we have collected in this lifetime.
- We know this is possible from our very own inventions. Just think of how much more ADVANCED God is with HIS inventions.
- In fact, it is only through the Grace of God that He chose one day to allow mankind to discover this invisible world of electronics and radio waves.
 - They always existed, but God led mankind to discover them, just as Jesus wanted us to discover the Supernatural Life through him!

- Right now, everything we see around us, from plants, animals, insects and humans—have a limited amount of time to exist in their *physical* state.
 - We all eventually die and the atoms and energy in us will be <u>Transformed</u> into another "state of being."
- Albert Einstein stated in his "Law of Conservation" that:
 "Energy can neither be created, nor destroyed, it can only be <u>Transformed</u> from one type of Energy into another..."
- You see, we are "flesh and blood" but we are also "Soul."
 Our body will break down and die one day, but our <u>SOUL</u> was designed—like ENERGY—to last FOREVER!
- We you really think about it, our SOUL—is "digital."
- And one day, we will live in the invisible, Spiritual realm—the "digital world" we <u>know</u> exists—until we get our mortal bodies back just like Jesus did.
- Remember, as the *Nicene Creed* says, "we look forward to the resurrection of the dead" (see also, CCC 1017)
 - just as Jesus' Spirit re-entered his mortal body after descending to the lower world to preach the Gospel to those Souls seeking salvation.

- The Bible tells us that when Jesus returns to earth, he will
 <u>physically</u> raise all those who have died, giving them back their
 physical bodies they lost at death (1 Cor. 15:35–44, 1 John 3:2).
- However, our resurrected bodies will not die. They will be transformed into a *Glorified State*, just like Jesus' body was at his resurrection.
- This *Glorified Spiritual State* of our Body and Soul will be free from suffering and pain, and enabled to do many of the amazing things Jesus could do with his glorified body.
 - If you would like to learn more about WHY we believe what God tells us in Sacred Scripture, then please refer to Paragraphs 988 to 1019 in the Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC).
- Now, don't ask me exactly <u>HOW</u> this will happen. But I believe that with God, "all things are possible!" (Mt. 19:26; Mk 10:27).
 After all, that's what makes Him—GOD!
- And if you don't believe that "all things are possible with God," then try designing a DNA strand, or an echo system, or better yet, a galaxy, or even something as simple as a "seed."
 - Mankind can do none of these things.

- Yes, we invented the "Smart phone" through God feeding us a little bit of information at a time on how to do it,
 - but overall, compared to the many wonders in our world and universe, mankind is like an "amoeba" compared to what God can do...
- Whenever I read about the *Transfiguration* of our Lord,
 I can't help but think of "Near Death Experiences."
- An "NDE" (Near Death Experience) is when a person's Soul leaves their body after they die; they experience the "afterlife," and their Soul is then sent back into their body!
- Many NDE's speak about the "Brilliance of Light" they see around them and how much more beautiful the world is in this "Glorified" state than it is in the Physical State.
- In the 1980's, Fiber Optics used *bands of LIGHT* to carry digital information anywhere in the world.
 - We now have <u>WiFi</u> that does the same thing <u>invisibly</u>.
- Right now, there are trillions of bits of Digital Information about color, sights and sound passing through the air around us.

- Do you hear them? Do you see them? <u>NO!</u>
 Are they there? Are they real? <u>YES!</u>
 - We know they are there because we can download this information to our computers and cell phones.
- We take a video of our grandchild talking here, and we BEAM it with "energy and light" around the world and the same digital information is seen by someone else thousands of miles away.
- If we were to tell someone 200 years ago that this was the way the world would be one day, they would have thought we were CRAZY!
 - They would have said, "THAT is, and always will be, *IMPOSSIBLE*!"
- But again, brothers and sisters, with the Power and Supremacy of God—<u>ALL</u> things are possible!
- The *Transfiguration* happened before Jesus began his journey to Jerusalem to lay down his life as the *Sacrificial Lamb* for our sins (Ex 12:11-13; Lev 4:32; Lev 17:1-17; Lev 23:12; Jer 11:19, Is 53:7; Is 53:10, Jn 1:29; Jn 1:36; Rm 8:3, Heb 10).

- He knows that once he declares before the Sanhedrin that he is truly the "begotten Son of God," they will put him to death for blasphemy (Lev 24:10-23).
- Jesus knows this will be troubling times for his Apostles. The Shepherd is about to be struck and his sheep will scatter in fear (Zech 13:7; Mt 26:31, Mk 14:27).
- Jesus wants to show Peter, James and John that they have <u>nothing</u> to fear. By revealing to them his Glorified Spiritual State he is showing the full side of his <u>Divinity</u>.
- Today's Gospel reading focuses on the *Transfiguration* of Jesus and reveals what happened to <u>him</u>. But what happened to Peter, John and James?
 - What about <u>THEIR</u> Transformation in Christ?... What about
 OURS...?
- Even though Peter, John and Johns were temporally amazed by Jesus' *Transfiguration*, his <u>Resurrected Glorified Body</u> would motivate them—and the other Apostles—to tell the world about the Son of God!
- In a similar way, our encounters with God must <u>transform</u> our lives and motivate <u>us</u> to want to tell the world about Christ!

- In our busy world that demands more of our time and energy on a daily basis, we are tempted to cast aside our faith to place God somewhere further down our list of priorities.
- If God is not at the <u>Top</u> of our *List of Priorities*, we are missing the opportunity to be *Transformed* by him.
- Since Lent is our time to be transformed, now is a good time to ask: "What transformation do I still need to make to become more like Christ?"
- Yes, I know. It's not easy to live according to everything that
 Jesus teaches us in the Gospel. We need the <u>Transformative</u>
 <u>Power</u> of the Lord to help us!
 - What is the "Transformative Power" of the Lord? His GRACE! His Supernatural, Real Presence, living and growing in us!
- Transcendence comes only through death and resurrection.
 We must "die" of our old ways, and be "born again" in Christ in all ways!
- The more we open our HEART and MIND to invite the *Love* of Christ, the *Wisdom* of Christ; the *Compassion* of Christ into our

SOUL, the more we will begin to <u>think</u> and <u>act</u> like him in all ways.

- As our *Responsorial Psalm* says today, "The LORD is my LIGHT and MY *Salvation*... Your presence O Lord, I seek!"
- May we "seek" to be *Transformed* by our Lord from all the people and events we encounter in our Lenten Journey by seeing the *beauty* and *presence* of God in them...
