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Introduction

Welcome to the informative guide of the ADDRESSING DIVERSITY project.

This initiative arises from the necessity and fundamental right of families with children with Specific Educational Support Needs to access comprehensive information related to the educational system to which they may have access.

We recognize the importance for families to know their rights, the available resources, the professionals involved in caring for their children within the educational environment, as well as specialized resources for school support outside of educational centers.

Who are the students with Specific Educational Support Needs?

Students with Specific Educational Support Needs refer to those students who, at some point in their educational journey, require specific supports or attentions to achieve the goals established in the curriculum corresponding to their level and age. These needs can manifest in various ways and encompass a wide range of situations that may affect their learning and academic development.

Within this group, we can find different categories that encompass different types of needs:

- Special Educational Needs: This group includes students who have some form of disability or specific difficulty that requires curriculum adaptations, technical support, or additional resources to fully participate in the educational process. These difficulties can be physical, sensory, cognitive, or developmental in origin, and may affect areas such as communication, mobility, or learning.
- Gifted and Talented: Refers to students whose intellectual abilities are significantly above average and who require adapted educational programs to meet their specific needs. These students may have exceptional potential in areas such as cognition, creativity, or leadership, and may benefit from differentiated educational approaches that stimulate their holistic development.

- Special Personal Conditions or Complex School History: This g
 encompasses students who face particular personal or family
 circumstances that may affect their academic performance and
 integration into the educational environment. This may include
 experiences of trauma, mental health issues, socio-economic
 vulnerability, or difficulties related to migration and late entry into the
 educational system.
- Late Entry into the Educational System: Refers to students who join the educational system at advanced stages of their development, such as newly arrived immigrants, refugees, or individuals returning to education after a prolonged period outside the system. These students may require specific support to adapt to their new school reality and achieve established academic goals.

Course Modalities.



In-Person Course Modality for Parents of Children with Specific Educational Support Needs: We provide a space for direct interaction, with relevant and up-to-date content, interactive sessions, the presence of specialized professionals, moments for reflection, and ongoing support. We strive to offer tools and support so that families can enhance the educational development of their children with Specific Educational Support Needs.

- Self-Care and Personal Well-being: Emphasizing the importance of self-care, offering strategies to maintain balance between caregiving responsibilities and personal well-being.
- Understanding Each Child's Unique Needs: Exploring how each child's personal and school experiences can influence their learning and development.
