Project Coverage

Karamoja sub-region: 3 District and 6 Sub-counties • Kaabong: Loyoro, Timu • Kotido: Nakapelimoru, Rengen • Moroto: Nadunget, Rupa

Envisaged Beneficiaries

12,800 direct beneficiaries and 60,000 indirect beneficiaries, with attention to target vulnerable groups such as women, youths, Persons with Disabilities, elderly, and former warriors.

Project Period

28 months

(November 2023- February 2026)

Goal

To promote sustainable development through capacity building to manage social economic risks and gender responsive livelihoods.

Objective 2:

To facilitate the increase of incomes for vulnerable households through environmentally friendly livelihoods options and strengthening essential service institutions in three districts of Karamoja sub-region.

Activities:

- · Cash for Work interventions.
- Support for Technical Vocational Education training, formation of Village Saving and Loan Associations (VSLAs) and Small Medium Enterprises (SMEs).
- Provision of start-up kits to youth and vulnerable groups.
- Support Local Governments in establishing and digitizing the Local Economic Business Centres (LEBCs) for innovation and implementation of start-ups.
- Support Local Governments to develop disaster risk sensitive planning and integrate resilient, gender-responsive and conflict sensitive livelihood interventions in development plans and budgets.

Objectives 1:

To promote peaceful co-existence through functional peace infrastructure and peace dividends for cross border communities in Karamoja.

Activities:

- Provision of shared resource pool (Water for production and domestic use).
- Promotion of cross-border and inter-district cooperation, and establishment of market linkages.
- Capacity strengthening for regional and local peace mechanisms.
- · Sensitisation and Outreach.
- Support to strengthen coordination forums.
- Provision of psychosocial support.


Expected Outcomes

Strengthened gender responsive livelihoods and resilience actions.
