RESOLUTION NO. 22, Series of 2026

**A RESOLUTION PROVIDING THE UNIFORM
REPORTORIAL REQUIREMENTS (URR) TEMPLATE
ADDENDUM PURSUANT TO RESOLUTION NO. 04, SERIES
OF 2026, ENTITLED “ADOPTING THE SUPPLEMENTAL
GUIDELINES ON THE ADJUSTMENT AND RECOVERY OF
TRANSMISSION AND ANCILLARY SERVICES CHARGES
UNDER ERC RESOLUTION NO. 14, SERIES OF 2022”**

WHEREAS, the Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission) is mandated under Republic Act No. 9136, otherwise known as the Electric Power Industry Reform Act of 2001 (*EPIRA*), to ensure transparent and reasonable electricity prices, protect consumer welfare, and promote public accountability in the electric power industry;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the *EPIRA*, the Commission is authorized to regulate the transmission and distribution of electricity, including the approval of rate structures, billing mechanisms, and cost recovery methodologies of regulated entities;

WHEREAS, as part of its regulatory authority, the Commission is mandated to ensure that regulated entities implement rates that are consistent with the Commission’s approvals through efficient and effective monitoring mechanisms;

WHEREAS, the Commission promulgated ERC Resolution No. 14, Series of 2022, otherwise known as the “*Revised Rules Governing the Automatic Cost Adjustment and True-Up Mechanisms and Corresponding Confirmation Process for Distribution Utilities*,” which governs the monitoring, adjustment and recovery of pass-through costs;

WHEREAS, on 30 September 2024, the National Grid Corporation of the Philippines (NGCP) filed a *Petition* entitled “*In the Matter of the Petition to Amend the Guidelines for the Adjustment of Transmission Rates by Distribution Utilities*,” docketed as ERC Case No. 2024-009 RM, seeking the amendment of existing guidelines and/or the promulgation of rules governing the adjustment, billing,

and recovery of Transmission and Ancillary Services (AS) charges by Distribution Utilities (DUs);

WHEREAS, the Commission, after due evaluation and consideration of the said *Petition* and the submissions made therein, issued ERC Resolution No. 04, Series of 2026, entitled "*A Resolution Adopting the Supplemental Guidelines on the Adjustment and Recovery of Transmission and Ancillary Services Charges under ERC Resolution No. 14, Series of 2022*," to promote regulatory clarity, transparency, and public accountability, without resulting in any new or additional charges to consumers;

WHEREAS, on 24 June 2026, the Commission approved the issuance of an **Addendum** to the Computation of Transmission Rate (TR) and Ancillary Services Charge Rate (ASCR),¹ attached hereto as "**ANNEX A**" and made an integral part of this Resolution, to implement ERC Resolution No. 04, Series of 2026;

WHEREAS, the Addendum prescribes the computation methodologies, templates, reportorial requirements, validation procedures, and other operational guidelines necessary for the implementation, monitoring, verification, adjustment, recovery, and true-up of Transmission Charges and Ancillary Services Charges under the Over/Under Recovery Monitoring System;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission hereby adopts this Addendum, which shall serve as the applicable operational and computational guide pending the promulgation of the revised Over/Under Recovery Rules under ERC Case No. 2024-003 RM.²

The Addendum shall take effect immediately upon the issuance and effectivity of this Resolution. However, all Distribution Utilities shall implement the revised computation procedures and reportorial requirements prescribed therein beginning with the first billing cycle commencing after 16 July 2026, in accordance with the transitory provisions of ERC Resolution No. 04, Series of 2026.

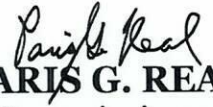
