Peer-Support Housing that Empowers Independence

Q: What is Empowered Community Living?

We provide peer-support housing only. Residents live together, support each other, and manage their own daily needs.

Q: Who can live in your homes?

We welcome veterans, seniors, individuals in recovery, re-entry populations, survivors of domestic violence, youth, and more.

Q: Do you provide meals, personal care, or medical support?

No. Residents are responsible for their own meals, medications, and personal care.

Q: How is this different from a group home or shelter?

Group homes and shelters often provide staff, meals, or services. Our homes are peer-run, resident-governed, and self-sufficient.

Q: How do finances work?

Residents contribute a set monthly amount to cover rent, utilities, and household costs. This makes housing affordable.

Q: How are the homes managed without staff?

Residents hold house meetings, share rules, and hold each other accountable. ECLS oversees homes at a distance.

Q: What does the application process look like?

1. Referral or application submitted.
2. Eligibility review to confirm independence.
3. Matching and orientation.
4. Move-in and peer integration.

Q: Are residents tenants?

No. Residents are program participants, not tenants. They sign a Program Participation Agreement instead of a lease.

Q: Where are your homes located?

Our homes are established in safe, accessible communities across Michigan, with plans to expand further.
