**SUBJECT: SUBMISSION OF SUPPORTING STATEMENT CONCERNING
ALLEGED VIOLATIONS OF HUMAN RIGHTS BY THE
ITALIAN GOVERNMENT – GIUSEPPE BUONCONSIGLIO**

RESUME OF MY PERSONAL INCIDENT

Dear Sir or Madam,

My name is Giuseppe Buonconsiglio and I'm respectfully submitting this communication to bring to your attention what I believe to be serious and ongoing violations of my fundamental human rights by the Italian government. This statement is submitted in support of my formal request for intervention and review under the relevant provisions of European and international human rights law:

- **Initial Incident (29 September 2020)**

On 29 September 2020, I was residing in Turin, Italy, when I received an urgent telephone call to return home immediately to assist and support my family. This event marked the beginning of the serious difficulties I and my relatives have since endured.

- **Legal Proceedings and Retaliation**

Following my efforts to resolve a complex legal dispute involving certain Italian governmental authorities—arising from events connected to my father and family—I was subjected to a campaign of retaliation. In response to my legitimate complaints, my privacy and personal well-being were systematically violated. On 8 April 2024, I suffered a heart attack in my rented apartment and required emergency medical treatment.

- **Obstructions to Justice and Continuing Harassment**

Despite numerous health-related examinations, police reports, and legal filings, I have encountered persistent obstacles. The authorities have repeatedly disregarded both the law and the Constitution, continuing covert activities aimed at undermining my life and health.

- **Professional and Personal Harassment**

As part of this campaign:

- My electronic devices, email accounts, and telephone communications have been monitored to impede my job searches and requests for medical assistance.
- Attempts to change my name and surname, or to relocate within the EU and elsewhere (e.g., Andorra), have been foiled.
- I have been denied the opportunity to obtain new employment in Italy.

- **Loss of Fundamental Rights**

Since the onset of these events, I have effectively lost:

- **Privacy:** My every action—in private and in public—is monitored.
- **Freedom of Movement and Association:** I cannot form friendships or pursue personal relationships without interference.
- **Economic Opportunity:** I am unable to open a business or secure gainful employment.
- **Personal Safety:** I have suffered identity theft, SIM-card and smartphone theft, and repeated cyber-attacks.

- **Health and Well-being:** My physical and mental health have deteriorated; any further relapse is likely to be dismissed as “stress and anxiety,” despite detailed medical records proving otherwise.

For example, during a two-week stay in the Czech Republic, my symptoms were initially downplayed; only twelve months later was a mild heart condition formally diagnosed, indicating an attempt to conceal the extent of my injuries at the time of treatment.

- **Current Deficiencies in Italy**

I can no longer enjoy the basic rights and protections to which every citizen is entitled:

- **Personal Security** (from both governmental and criminal actors).
 - **Access to Healthcare**
 - **Equal Opportunity to Work**
 - **Freedom from Unwarranted Surveillance**
 - **Right to Family Life**
 - **Protection of Property** (including my place of birth)
 - **Provision of Basic Necessities** (food, water, etc.)

FURTHER DETAILS ABOUT VIOLATION OF THE FOLLOWING ARTICLES OF EU CONVENTION – HUMAN RIGHTS

Below, I outline the specific articles of the European Convention on Human Rights and its Protocols that I believe have been infringed upon, along with a brief contextual reference

SECTION 1 – RIGHTS AND FREEDOMS ALLEGEDLY VIOLATED

ART. 1 – OBLIGATION TO RESPECT HUMAN RIGHTS



Instead, according to my point of view:

Despite the duty of the State to secure to everyone the rights and freedoms defined in the Convention, I believe the Italian authorities have failed to do so in my case.

ART. 2 – RIGHT TO LIFE

The article above indicated says the following words:

“Everyone’s right to life shall be protected by law. No one shall be deprived of his life intentionally save in the execution of a sentence of a court following his conviction of a crime for which this penalty is provided by law.”

“Deprivation of life shall not be regarded as inflicted in contravention of this Article when it results from the use of force which is no more than necessary:

- *in defence of any person from unlawful violence.*
- *In order to effect a lawful arrest or to prevent the escape of a person lawfully detained.*

- *in action lawfully taken for the purpose of quelling a riot or insurrection.”*



Instead, according to my point of view:

The State has a fundamental duty to protect life. I believe certain actions or inactions by Italian public authorities have placed my safety at risk, in contradiction with Article 2, paragraphs 1 and 2. [I am prepared to provide specific incidents upon request.]

ART. 5 – RIGHT TO LIBERTY AND SECURITY

The article above indicated says the following words:

Everyone has the right to liberty and security of person. No one shall be deprived of his liberty save in the following cases and in accordance with a procedure prescribed by law:

- *The lawful detention of a person after conviction by a competent court.*
- *The lawful arrest or detention of a person for non-compliance with the lawful order of a court or in order to secure the fulfilment of any obligation prescribed by law.*
- *The lawful arrest or detention of a person effected for the purpose of bringing him before the competent legal authority on reasonable suspicion of having committed an offence or when it is reasonably considered necessary to prevent his committing an offence or fleeing after having done so;*
- *The detention of a minor by lawful order for the purpose of educational supervision or his lawful detention for the purpose of bringing him before the competent legal authority.*
- *The lawful detention of persons for the prevention of the spreading of infectious diseases, of persons of unsound mind, alcoholics or drug addicts or vagrants.*
- *The lawful arrest or detention of a person to prevent his effecting an unauthorized entry into the country or of a person against whom action is being taken with a view to deportation or extradition.*
- *Everyone who is arrested shall be informed promptly, in a language which he understands, of the reasons for his arrest and of any charge against him.*

- *Everyone arrested or detained in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 1 (c) of this article shall be brought promptly before a judge or other officer authorized by law to exercise judicial power and shall be entitled to trial within a reasonable time or to release pending trial. Release may be conditioned by guarantees to appear for trial.*
- *Everyone who is deprived of his liberty by arrest or detention shall be entitled to take proceedings by which the lawfulness of his detention shall be decided speedily by a court and his release ordered if the detention is not lawful.*
- *Everyone who has been the victim of an arrest or detention in contravention of the provisions of this article shall have an enforceable right to compensation.*



Instead, according to my point of view:

I allege that I have been subjected to unjustified limitations on my liberty without legal basis or due process, contrary to the guarantees provided under Article 5.

ART. 8 – RIGHT TO RESPECT FOR PRIVATE AND FAMILY LIFE

The article above indicated says the following words:

Everyone has the right to respect for his private and family life, his home and his correspondence. There shall be no interference by a public authority with the exercise of this right except such as is in accordance with the law and is necessary in a democratic society in the interests of national security, public safety or the economic well-being of the country, for the prevention of disorder or crime, for the protection of health or morals, or for the protection of the rights and freedoms of others.



Instead, according to my point of view:

I believe there has been unlawful interference with my private and family life by governmental authorities, which was neither necessary in a democratic society nor justified by public interest or legal norms.

ART. 10 – FREEDOM OF EXPRESSION

Everyone has the right to freedom of expression. This right shall include freedom to hold opinions and to receive and impart information and ideas without interference by public authority and regardless of frontiers. This Article shall not prevent States from requiring the licensing of broadcasting, television or cinema enterprises.

The exercise of these freedoms, since it carries with it duties and responsibilities, may be subject to such formalities, conditions, restrictions or penalties as are prescribed by law and are necessary in a democratic society, in the interests of national security, territorial integrity or public safety, for the prevention of disorder or crime, for the protection of health or morals, for the protection of the reputation or rights of others, for preventing the disclosure of information received in confidence, or for maintaining the authority and impartiality of the judiciary. (I need to have clear and formal legal proofs – because they're not respecting the national law first)



Instead, according to my point of view:

My right to freely express myself, to receive and impart information, and to hold opinions has been restricted without legitimate justification. I respectfully request that the Court assess whether the national authorities have acted within their legal bounds.

Protocols to the Convention

ART. 1 OF PROTOCOL NO. 1 – PROTECTION OF PROPERTY

The article above indicated says the following words:

Every natural or legal person is entitled to the peaceful enjoyment of his possessions. No one shall be deprived of his possessions except in the public interest and subject to the conditions provided for by law and by the general principles of international law. The preceding provisions shall not, however, in any way impair the right of a State to enforce such laws as it deems necessary to control the use of property in accordance with the general interest or to secure the payment of taxes or other contributions or penalties.

Instead, according to my point of view:

I have experienced what I believe to be unjust deprivation and interference with my personal property, not justified by public interest or in accordance with the law.

ARTICLE 2 OF PROTOCOL NO. 4 - FREEDOM OF MOVEMENT

The article above indicated says the following words:

Everyone, lawfully within the territory of a State shall, within that territory, have the right to liberty of movement and freedom to choose his residence.

Everyone shall be free to leave any country, including his own.

No restrictions shall be placed on the exercise of these rights other than such as are in accordance with law and are necessary in a democratic society in the interests of national security or public safety, for the maintenance of public order, for the prevention of crime, for the protection of health or morals, or for the protection of the rights and freedoms of others.

The rights set forth in paragraph 1 may also be subject, in particular areas, to restrictions imposed in accordance with law and justified by the public interest in a democratic society.

If you are lawfully within a country, you have the right to go where you want and to live where you want within it.



Instead, according to my point of view:

My right to freedom of movement within my country and to leave it freely has been restricted in ways that appear neither necessary nor proportionate in a democratic society.

REQUEST FOR ACTION

Considering the above, I respectfully request that the Court acknowledge receipt of this supporting statement and advise me on the steps necessary to proceed with a formal complaint or application. Should you require additional details, documentation, or legal arguments, I am ready and willing to provide them promptly.
