Health & Safety:

- No COVID-19 vaccination is currently required.
- Emergency healthcare is available; bring necessary medications and basic first-aid items.
- No Yellow Fever vaccine is required unless traveling from a risk country.

Visa Requirements:

Effective April 1, 2025, Namibia has updated its visa requirements for travelers from several countries, including the United States, the United Kingdom, and most European Union nations. Travelers from these countries are now required to obtain a visa on arrival. Apply for an e-visa in advance through Namibia's online visa application system to ensure a smooth entry process. Print your approval and carry with you for entry into Namibia.

Application Process:

- Online Application: Submit your visa application through Namibia's official e-visa portal. <https://eservices.mhaiss.gov.na/visaonarrival>

Visa Fees:

- NAD 1,600 (approximately USD 88) for non-African travelers.
- NAD 1,200 for African travelers.

Validity:

The visa is valid for multiple entries within 90 days from the date of issue. [Visas News](#)
