Belladonna (Deadly Nightshade)

- Ritual Use: Divination, shadow work, transformation
- Placement: North side of your altar
- Intent: Lift veil, unveil hidden knowledge

Henbane

- Ritual Use: Communication with spirit guides, dream magic
- Placement: West side of your altar
- Intent: Enter dream worlds safely, connect with ancestors



Working with Magickal Poisonous Plants

Datura

(Jimsonweed or Devil's Trumpet)

- Ritual Use: Protection, breaking negativity, securing a space
- Placement: South side of your altar
- Intent: Ward off harm and negativity

Foxglove

- Ritual Use: Healing messages, faery magic
- Placement: East side of your altar
- Intent: Foster faery guidance, aid healing routines

Amanita Muscaria (Fly Agaric)

- Ritual Use: Shamanistic journeys, transformation, deepening magic
- Placement: Center of your altar
- Intent: Expand consciousness, unveil hidden worlds

Yew

- Ritual Use: Ancestral magic, eternal connection, renewal
- Placement: All around your circle
- Intent: Connect with ancestors, eternal renewal, transformation
