

WHO IS EOStRE?

Eostre (sometimes spelled Ostara) is a Germanic goddess of spring and dawn, whose name is believed to be the root of the word Easter. She governs rebirth, fertility, balance, and new beginnings, standing at the threshold between winter's rest and spring's awakening.

Sacred Symbols of Eostre

- Hares & Rabbits — Fertility, intuition, and moon magic
- Eggs — Potential, rebirth, and creation waiting to hatch
- Flowers — Especially crocus, daffodil, and violet
- The Dawn Sun — New light and fresh perspective
- Pastel Colors — Soft pinks, greens, yellows, and sky blue

Everything sacred to Eostre carries the message: Life is beginning again.



Working with Eostre's Energy

Eostre is a beautiful ally when you are:

- Beginning a new chapter
- Healing after a difficult season
- Reconnecting with joy and creativity
- Planting intentions or dreams
- Learning to trust natural timing

Her energy is especially strong during the Spring Equinox, when day and night stand in perfect balance.



A Simple Eostre Ritual: Blessing the Seeds



YOU'LL NEED:

- A candle (white, yellow, or soft green)
- Seeds, an egg, or a stone to represent new beginnings
- A small bowl of soil or water



STEPS:

1. Light your candle at sunrise or early morning.
2. Hold your seeds or symbol and say:
3. "Eostre, Bringer of Dawn,
4. Bless what is ready to grow.
5. From rest to renewal,
6. From dream to becoming."
7. Place the seeds in soil or hold the symbol over water, infusing it with intention.
8. Sit quietly and imagine your intentions taking root.

Let the candle burn for a few moments, then offer gratitude.

Final Thoughts

Eostre teaches us that rebirth does not always arrive with fireworks. Sometimes it comes quietly—through hope, patience, and trust in the cycles of life. She reminds us that after every winter within us, spring is already stirring.

To walk with Eostre is to believe again.
