March Demo: Gene Youngmann, Hydrus Watercolor



Gene Youngmann is a well-known Colorado plein air painter using Dr. Ph Martin Hydrus watercolors. His favorite subjects are landscapes, vintage architecture and old vehicles. He is a signature member of the Colorado Watercolor Society, Master Signature of the Western Colorado Watercolor Society and Rocky Mountain National Water Media Society, accepted nine times since 1988. He taught drawing at Golden High School, retiring from Jeffco Schools in May 2003.

Most recently, he was the "Best in Watercolor" in the Art From The Heart Fine Art Exhibit 2026 at the College Hill Library.

Increase in Membership Dues

The Executive Board is recommending an increase in Paletteers annual dues to \$40.

1. Dues have not increased for over 30 years
2. Prices for everything have increased - examples are rent, postage, insurance, artist demo fees, bookkeeping fees.
3. We have to increase our annual income to cover expenses. If dues are not increased we will have to find another way to add income like taking a commissions on all art sales including sales at the MAC and Fuse Box, etc. or increase entry fees to our shows. Possibly having a fundraiser. It's a lot easier to just increase our dues.
4. We have to show income to leverage our SCFD Funding. They will only fund 50% of a project's costs.
5. \$40 is approximately \$3.30 per month. Don't we all get that much benefit from being a member of Paletteers Art Club?

Basic Watercolor Techniques with Linden
