I'm looking forward to presenting for the Paletteers! For this demonstration I'll be painting in soft pastel but know that the concepts apply to any medium. The focus will be on designing your paintings by starting with thumbnail notans (shadow and light families in black marker) to develop a strong shadow and light composition. Once a good foundation is conceptualized, then we move into a block-in and build layers of color from loose large shapes developing into tighter smaller shapes to achieve the desired level of detail.


