LIGHT AND MAGIC

CYANOTYPE DEMONSTRATION

VIKKI GRAY

Cyanotypes are created by laying objects on paper coated with a light-sensitive chemical. The paper is then exposed to the sun until an image is formed. The result is pure serendipity and cannot be replicated again. In general, cyanotypes are blue and white, but there are infinite variations due to tannins in the plants, intensity of light, and colorants added to the mix. Cyanotypes can also be created on glass, fabric, or even rocks.

Vikki began as a potter and sculptor in college and later moved into painting. In 2019, she retired from the oil and gas industry. Retirement gave her the time to experiment with watercolor and cyanotypes. Her cyanotypes have been on display at The Georgetown Gallery and the Artists Gallery in Canon City.

She is a member of the Wheat Ridge Art League and the Arvada Fine Arts Guild.
