September – Linden Kirby, “How to Make Your Painting Stand Out: Adding Depth and Drama No Matter What Medium You Use”

Linden Kirby’s presentation and demonstration at our September 8th meeting will help us all to strengthen our composition skills by applying three key principles to our paintings. Linden has won dozens of awards for his art, and he has analyzed hundreds of successful paintings. He will demonstrate how to turn a good photo into a poetic painting by simplifying, strategizing, and strengthening the composition. These techniques work for all painting mediums and not only for landscapes but other types and styles of painting, too.

BIO for LINDEN KIRBY

As a resident of Westminster for 40 years, Linden Kirby enjoyed the many Paletteers art exhibits hosted at College Hill Library. It was obvious to him that this local club had many talented artists, and he told himself that someday he would join that club. Then when he retired in 2017, Paletteers was the first art club he joined.

Watercolor is Linden's primary medium, but he also enjoys the challenge of new media and trying different techniques that improve the quality and enjoyment of art. He finds inspiration most often in the beauty of God's creation, so landscapes, trees, and nature are some of his favorite subjects.

Linden believes that art touches the heart when it tells a story, evokes an emotion, or brings back a memory. So, he chooses his subjects carefully and paints with the idea of telling a story through the image and the medium.

In addition to being a member of Paletteers, he is also a member of the [American Watercolor Society](#), the [National Watercolor Society](#), the Arvada Center's Artists Circle, and a Signature Member of the [Colorado Watercolor Society](#).

His paintings have received many awards including “Best of Show” in “This Is Colorado.” And his paintings hang in the permanent collection of the City of Westminster, and also in the office of the mayor of Ueda, Nagano, Japan, a sister city of Broomfield, CO.
