



TWELVE SIGNS OF A CURSE

Do you have any curses in your life?

May all our prayers help us discern where the curses are in operation. *Once we recognize them the curse may be lifted by removal and revocation by the power of the mighty Holy, name of YHVH and Yeshua.*

Lets pray: Short Opening Prayer for Breaking the Twelve Curses

"Heavenly Father, in the mighty name of Yeshua, I come before Your Courts of Heaven today. I stand on the blood of Yeshua and the authority of Your Word to renounce and break every curse operating in my life and lineage. By the power of Galatians 3:13, I declare that Mashiah Christ has redeemed me from every curse of the law.

I repent for all sins, known and unknown, that opened doors to these curses. I cancel every legal right the enemy has held against me by agreeing and silencing every accusing voice (Rev. 12:10) and nullify every curse of fear, failure, sickness, lack, oppression, and spiritual blockage by asking for Yeshuas advocacy and his precious blood. Lord, let Your mercy and justice prevail. Soften the heavens over me (Deut. 28:23) and release Your divine breakthrough. I decree by Yeshua name every curse is broken, every chain is loosed, and Your blessing now overtakes me (Deut. 28:2). In Yeshua's victorious name, Amen, Amen

כַּצְפוֹר לְנוֹד, כְּדֶרֶר לְעוֹף- בֶּן קָלִיל חָנָם, לֹא תִבָּא

Like a flitting sparrow, like a flying swallow, so a curse without a cause cannot alight

Proverbs 26:2

The adversary or *Ha'satan* or *antidikos* means "one who brings a lawsuit" to land curses to destroy us. A curse is always the result of a case against us in the spiritual realm. It has a lawful right to be operating because of our or our ancestors:

through:

1. פֶּשַׁע ***Pesha***, rebellious sin,
2. עֲוֹן ***Avon***, transgression, and
3. חַטָּאת ***Cheit***, iniquity.

The word קללה "curse" appears in the Torah almost 200 times. God Almighty cursed Satan for tempting Eve into sin;

Genesis 3:17. וַיֹּאמֶר יְהוָה אֱלֹהִים אֶל-הַנָּחַשׁ, כִּי עָשִׂיתָ זֹאת, אֲרוּרָה אַתָּה מִכָּל-הַבְּהֵמָה, וּמִכָּל חַיַּת הַשָּׂדֶה

He indirectly cursed all mankind when he cursed the earth ground so thorns and weeds would sprout causing man to work hard and sweat in order to make a living from the cursed earth;

וּלְאָדָם אָמַר כִּי-שָׁמַעְתָּ לְקוֹל אִשְׁתְּךָ, וַתֹּאכַל מִן-הָעֵץ, אֲשֶׁר צִוִּיתִיךָ לֵאמֹר לֹא תֹאכַל מִמֶּנּוּ--**אֲרוּרָה הָאֲדָמָה**, בַּעֲבוּרְךָ
Genesis 3:17-19.

In **Gen 4:10**, God placed a curse upon Cain for killing his brother:

וַעֲתָה, אֲרוּרָה אַתָּה, מִן-הָאֲדָמָה אֲשֶׁר פָּצְתָה אֶת-פִּיהָ, לִקְחוֹת אֶת-דַּמִּי אֶחָיִךְ מִיָּדְךָ.
Noah cursed his son Ham when Ham raped him while he was drunk and naked:

he said, "*Cursed be Canaan; The slave of slaves Shall he be to his brothers.*" **Gen 9:18-25.**

Moses declares;

הַעֲדוֹתִי בָכֶם הַיּוֹם, אֶת-הַשָּׁמַיִם וְאֶת-הָאָרֶץ--הַחַיִּים וְהַמֵּוֹת נִתְּנִי לְפָנֶיךָ, הַבְּרָכָה וְהַקְּלָלָה; וּבַחֲרֹתְךָ, בְּחַיִּים
"*This day I call the heavens and the earth as witnesses against you that I have set before you life and death, **blessings and curses**. Now choose life, so that you and your children may live.*"
Deut 30:19

If you are a threat to satan he has demonic powers searching bloodlines to build cases against you lawfully, preventing your destiny. If you advance your books destiny **Jer 29** you will build the kingdom of YHVH and:

גָּלְמִי, רְאוּ עֵינֶיךָ וְעַל-סִפְּרֹךְךָ, כָּלֵם יִכְתְּבוּ:
Psalms 139:16 יָמִים יִצְרוּ; וְלֹא (וְלֹא) אֶחָד בָּהֶם

Therefore;

הָיוּ עֲרוּכִים וְשָׁלוּטוֹ בַּעֲצָמָם. הָאוֹיֵב שָׁלָכֶם, הַשָּׂטָן, מִתְהַלֵּךְ בְּאַרְצֶיךָ שׂוֹאֵג וּמַחֲפִישׁ אֶת מִי לְבַלְעַ. הַתְּנַגְּדוּ לוֹ, עֲמַדוּ אִיתָן
בְּאַמוּנָה... 1 כִּיפָא 5:8-9

"*Be alert and of sober mind. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to **devour**. Resist him, standing firm in the faith...*" **1 Peter 5:8-9.**

We must consider that we have a demonic adversary who has a backpack and hedge full of filthy, dirty and deceitful spiritual tools designed to inflict harm and destruction upon unsuspecting, real followers of *Yeshuah*. Ultimately, breaking free from a curse/s requires deep introspection and an honest willingness to acknowledge our

sins and repent truly and fully. Generational curses are also central as curses can be passed down from generation to generation if they are not properly broken:

נִצַּר חֶסֶד לְאֲלָפִים, נִשְׂא עוֹן וְפָשַׁע וְחַטָּאת; וְנִקָּה, לֹא יִנָּקֶה--פֶּקֶד עוֹן אָבוֹת עַל-בָּנִים וְעַל-בְּנֵי בָנִים, עַל-שְׁלֹשִׁים וְעַל-רִבְעִים. *“maintaining love to thousands, and forgiving wickedness, rebellion and sin. Yet he does not leave the guilty unpunished; he punishes the children and their children for the sin of the parents to the third and fourth generation.” Exodus 34:7*

Four generations back yields *thirty* ancestors not including aunts or uncles, etc, which we are heir to!

Yahweh gives us a number of spiritual tools to resist, incapacitate and frustrate Satan in his attacks against us. First and foremost pray for God to encircle you with a spiritual hedge of protection as:

הֲלֹא-אַתָּה (אַתָּה) שִׁכַּתָּ בְּעָדוֹ וּבְעַד-בֵּיתוֹ, וּבְעַד כָּל-אֲשֶׁר-לוֹ--מִסְבִּיב: מַעֲשֵׂה יָדָיו בִּרְכַּת, וּמִקְנֵהוּ פֶרֶץ בְּאֶרֶץ. *"Hast not thou made a **hedge** about him, and about his house, and about all that he hath on every side? thou hast blessed the work of his hands..." Job 1:10:*

You want the protection and the blessing of prosperity as well. But Yahweh is a righteous judge so prayer will work, but if there are cases against you the judgements stand until they are dealt with properly. Every family, even the greatest of saints has iniquity working in its family history. Abraham sins twice:

Genesis 12:10-13 and וַיֹּאמֶר אַבְרָהָם אֶל-שָׂרָה אִשְׁתּוֹ, אַחֲתִי הִוא; וַיִּשְׁלַח, אַבִּימֶלֶךְ מֶלֶךְ גֵּרָר, וַיִּקַּח, אֶת-שָׂרָה. *Now Abraham said of Sarah his wife, ‘She is my sister.’ And Abimelech king of Gerar sent and took Sarah. Genesis 20:2*

Isaac does the same sin with Rebekah;

וַיִּשְׁאָלוּ אַנְשֵׁי הַמָּקוֹם, לְאִשְׁתּוֹ, וַיֹּאמֶר, אַחֲתִי הִוא: כִּי יָרָא, לֵאמֹר אִשְׁתִּי, כֹּן-יִהְיֶה אֲנִשִּׁי הַמָּקוֹם עַל-רֵבְקָה. *so Isaac dwelt in Gerar. And the men of the place asked about his wife. And he said she is my sister, “for he was afraid to say “she is my wife” because he thought, “lest the men of the place kill me for Rebekah for she is beautiful to behold.” Genesis 26:6-7*

Yet we must be aggressive in spirit to remove curses. Esau would have to become weary and restless before he could overcome and be free;

וְעַל-חֲרָבָה תִּחְיֶה, וְאֶת-אֲחִיךָ תַעֲבֹד; וְהָיָה כַּאֲשֶׁר תִּרְדּוּ, וּפָרַקְתָּ עָלוֹ מֵעַל צִוְּאָרְךָ. *and it shall come to pass, when you become restless, you shall break his yoke from your neck.” Gen 7:40*

Curses don't come immediately but:

There are 4 stages of a Curse:

- 1.` It comes upon us
- 2.` Pursues us
- 3.` Overtakes us
- 4.` Destroys us

...see *Jeroboam* as an example as curses are aggressive and relentless. Especially in a family line to stop the Kingdom. A generational curse:

In **1 Kings 13:34** וַיְהִי בְדִבְרֵי הַזֶּה, לְחַטֹּאת בֵּית יִרְבֵּעַם; וּלְהַכְחִיד, וּלְהַשְׁמִיד, מֵעַל, פְּנֵי הָאָדָמָה “*and the thing was the sin of the house of Jeroboam, so as to exterminate and destroy it from the face of the earth.*”

Here are Twelve signs of the existence of a curse;

1. The first thing a curse does is it creates a **negative attitude, mindset** and mentality. We don't anticipate good but instead expect evil. A mindset of life without vision, with pessimism and negativity.

וְהָיוּ חַיֶּיךָ, תְּלָאִים לָךְ מִנָּגֶד; וּפְחָדָה לַיְלָה וַיּוֹמָם, וְלֹא תֵאֱמָר בְּחַיֶּיךָ “*Your life shall hang in doubt before you; you shall fear day and night and have no assurance of life.*” **Deut 28:66**

2. The second trait of a curse is **inevitability**. You can't seem to escape it. Bad things chase you down, no matter where, no matter what. Nothing works it *always falls apart*. Something always sabotages every hopeful thing and your destiny. It is **not** an issue of effort.

אָרוּר אַתָּה, בְּבֹאֶךָ; וְאָרוּר אַתָּה, בְּצֵאתְךָ *Cursed shall you be when you come in, and cursed shall you be when you go out.* **Deut 28:19**

3. The third curse is **No vision** for life, you just try to get by day by day, aimless, not knowing your purpose for life. Blindness in Hebrew has as the root of a *film*. Once removed vision and destiny manifests and explodes.

וְהָיִיתָ מְמַשֵּׁשׁ בַּצְהָרִים, בְּאֶשֶׁר יִמָּשֵׁשׁ הָעוֹר בְּאֶפְלָה, וְלֹא תִצְלִיחַ, אֶת-דֶּרֶכְךָ; וְהָיִיתָ אֶף עֲשׂוֹק וְגָזוּל, כָּל-הַיָּמִים--
וְאַיִן מוֹשִׁיעַ. *And you shall grope at noonday, as a blind man gropes in darkness. You shall not prosper in your ways; you shall be only oppressed and plundered continually and no one shall save you.* **Deut 28:29**

4. The fourth trait of a curse is a **breakdown of marriages** and homes. Broken hearts and destruction of marriages. Divorce moves from generation to generation, leaving shattered lives and broken people. It can have generational impact:

אִשָּׁה תֵּאָרֵשׁ, וְאִישׁ אֲחֵר יִשְׁכַּב בָּהּ, וְלֹא תִשָּׁב בּוֹ; כָּרֵם תִּטְעַע, וְלֹא תִחְלָלְנָהּ. *You shall betroth a wife, but another man shall lie with her; you shall build a house but you shall not dwell in it.* **Deut 28:30**

5. A fifth curse is Children being taken captive, lost to someone or something. Heartbreaking to see captivity into drugs, alcohol, gangs, sexual immorality, depression or many other plagues. They become not what they were raised as;

בָּנִים וּבָנוֹת, תוֹלִיד; וְלֹא-יִהְיוּ לָךְ, כִּי יֵלְכוּ בַּשָּׁבִי. *You shall beget sons and daughters but they shall not be yours; for they shall go into captivity.* **Deut 28:41**

6. The sixth is ***no prosperity, scraping by***. A lack of harvest from produce or work. A devouring force eats it up.

You don't get what should naturally occur in business or work. You work hard but results are not equal to the labor. Adam labors but get thorns and thistles. Frustration even hard labor yield meager results:

וְנָרַע רֶבֿ, תוֹצִיא הַשָּׂדֶה; וּמַעַט תִּקְצֹר, כִּי יִקְצֹרְנָה הָאֲרָצָה. *You shall carry much seed out to the field but gather little in, for the locust shall consume it.* **Deut 28: 38**

7. A seventh sign of a curse operating is ***sicknesses do not be heal*** by doctors or don't respond to prayers of healing. Some family sicknesses are reoccurring. Reoccurring is indication of a family curse;

וְכָכָה יְהוָה בַּשָּׁחִין מִצָּרִים, וּבַעֲפָלִים (וּבְטֹחָרִים), וּבַגָּרֶב, וּבְחֹרֶס--אֲשֶׁר לֹא-תוּכַל, לְהִרְפֹּא. *The Lord will strike you with boils of Egypt, with tumors, with the scab and with the itch from which you cannot be healed.* **Deut 28:27** *The Lord will strike you in the knees and the legs with severe boils which cannot be healed and from the sole of your foot to the top of your head.* **Deut 28: 35**

Moreover he will back on you all the diseases of Egypt of which you were afraid and they shall cling to you. Also every sickness and every plague, which is not written in this book of the law will the Lord bring upon you until you are destroyed. **Deut 28:60**

8. The eighth sign of a curse is ***no anointing*** or a diminished case of anointing. Yokes remain, deliverances are stopped, breakthroughs do not occur:

יָיִתִּים יִהְיוּ לָךְ, בְּכָל-גְּבוּלָךְ; וְשֶׁמֶן לֹא תִסּוֹד, כִּי יִשַּׁל זֵיתְךָ. *"You shall have olive trees throughout all your territory but you shall not anoint yourself with the oil; for your olives shall drop off."* **Deut 28:40**

9. The ninth sign of a curse is **mental and/or emotional issues** which bring torment often in family lines.

וְהָיִיתָ, מְשֻׁעָ, מִמַּרְאֵה עֵינֶיךָ, אֲשֶׁר תִּרְאֶה” *So you shall be driven mad because of the sight which your eyes see*” **Deut 28: 34**

10. The tenth sign of a curse is **being stolen from** that which is rightfully yours. Especially when it was supposed to be yours. *Finances, marriages, health, children, jobs and reputations* all hindered and blocked destinies:

“שׁוֹרְךָ טְבוּחַ לְעֵינֶיךָ, וְלֹא תֹאכַל מִמֶּנּוּ--חֶמְרְךָ גָּזוּל מִלִּפְנֶיךָ, וְלֹא יָשׁוּב לָךְ; צֹאנְךָ נִתְּנוֹת לְאֹיְבֶיךָ, וְאִין לָךְ מוֹשִׁיעַ” *Your ox shall be slaughtered before your eyes, but you shall not eat of it; your donkey shall be violently taken away from before you, and shall not be restored to you; your sheep shall be given to your enemies, and you shall have no one to rescue them.*”

Deut 28:31

11. The Eleventh sign of a curse is you **miss promotions**.

Others are promoted ahead of you. We must be very cautious whom we are connected with. YHWH needs his people who will succeed and be in places of influence. Curses deny and prevent those influences and destiny.

הַגֵּר אֲשֶׁר בְּקִרְבְּךָ, יַעֲלֶה עָלֶיךָ מַעְלָה מַעְלָה; וְאַתָּה תִּרְדּוּ, מִטָּה מִטָּה” *The alien who is among you shall rise higher and higher above you, and you shall come down lower and lower.* **Deut 28:43**

12. The last trait is a curse stops **prayers not answered**. The heaven become as brass and earth as iron. Prayers that should be answered are not.

וְהָיוּ שָׁמַיִךָ אֲשֶׁר עַל-רִאשְׁךָ, נְחֹשֶׁת; וְהָאָרֶץ אֲשֶׁר-תַּחְתֶּיךָ, בְּרֹזָל” *And your heavens which shall be over your head shall be bronze, and the earth which is under you shall be iron.*

Deut 28:23

Lifting curse will soften the heaven and touch the earth with the rain of his grace. Prayers are answered. If we pray in agreement with YHVH and his word and prayers go unanswered for extended time something lawful is resisting us. A curse has found a way to land against us and must be revoked.

May all our prayers help us discern where the curses are in operation. *Once we recognize them the curse may be lifted by removal and revocation by the power of the mighty Holy, name of YHVH.*

THE REMEDY

Antidote and Remedy in the Courts of Heaven Against the 12 Curses

The Torah provides divine solutions to break curses through repentance (Teshuvah), prayer (Tefillah), and righteous acts (Tzedakah). Below are scriptural prayers and legal remedies to nullify these curses in the Courts of Heaven.

1. Negative Attitude (Deut. 28:66)

Prayer:

*"Father, in the name of Yeshua, I renounce the spirit of fear and unbelief. I break every curse of a **negative mindset** and declare that I walk in faith, hope, and divine assurance. Let Your perfect love cast out all fear **1 John 4:18**. I receive a renewed mind **Romans 12:2** and a spirit of power, love, and sound mind **2 Tim. 1:7**."*

Remedy:

Teshuvah (Repentance): Repent for any agreement with fear, doubt, or negativity.

Tefillah (Prayer): Pray for a spirit of faith **Mark 11:22-24**.

Tzedakah (Righteous Acts): Sow seeds of faith by speaking life **Prov. 18:21**.

2. Fatalistic Attitude Deut. 28:19

Prayer:

*"Lord, I cancel every curse of failure and sabotage. I decree that my steps are ordered by You **Psalm 37:23**.*

*No weapon formed against me shall prosper **Isaiah 54:17**. I break every generational curse of defeat and declare divine favor and success in all I do."*

Remedy:

Teshuvah: Repent for any agreement with **hopelessness**.

Tefillah: Pray for **divine strategy** **James 1:5**.

Tzedakah: Sow into someone else's breakthrough.

3. Purposelessness & Lost Vision Deut. 28:29

Prayer:

*"Father, remove the veil of blindness from my eyes. Restore my vision and destiny **Isaiah 42:7**). "I break every curse of confusion and declare that I walk in divine purpose **Jer. 29:11**.*

*Let Your light guide me " **Psalm 119:105**."*

Remedy:

Teshuvah: Repent for passivity or lack of seeking God's will.

Tefillah: Pray for prophetic revelation **Joel 2:28**.

Tzedakah: Help others discover their purpose.

4. Marital Breakdowns Deut. 28:30

Prayer:

"Lord, I break every curse of divorce, strife, and broken relationships. I decree restoration over my marriage/future marriage Mal. 2:16. Let love, peace, and unity reign. I nullify every generational curse of divorce in Yeshua's name."

Remedy:

Teshuvah: Repent for any marital sins (bitterness, unforgiveness).

Tefillah: Pray for covenant restoration Ezek. 36:26.

Tzedakah: Bless marriages around you.

5. Problem Children Deut. 28:41

Prayer:

"Father, I break every curse of rebellion, addiction, and captivity over my children. I declare that my household is saved Acts 16:31. I loose the spirit of captivity [Rom. 8:15] and decree that my children walk in divine destiny."

Remedy:

Teshuvah: Repent for any generational iniquity.

Tefillah: Pray for generational deliverance Isaiah 59:21.

Tzedakah: Minister to troubled youth.

6. Lack & Working Poverty Deut. 28:38

Prayer:

"Lord, I break every curse of lack, devouring, and frustration. I decree divine prosperity (3 John 1:2). Let my labor be fruitful Psalm 128:2. I rebuke the spirit of the locust and declare restoration Joel 2:25."

Remedy:

Teshuvah: Repent for greed or mismanagement.

Tefillah: Pray for financial breakthrough Mal. 3:10.

"Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the Lord of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it."

Key Breakdown of the Verse:

1. Command:

"Bring ye all the tithes" – God requires faithful tithing (10% of income, Lev. 27:30).

"Into the storehouse" – This refers to God's designated place (local church, ministry, or

1. Challenge: ***"Prove me now herewith"*** – God dares us to test Him in this (the only place in Scripture where God says to test Him).

3 Levels of Blessings in Malachi 3:10

1. Financial Breakthrough – God rebukes the “devourer” (**Mal. 3:11**) that steals from you.
2. Divine Protection – No more wasted resources (**Mal. 3:11**).
3. Nations Will Call You Blessed (**Mal. 3:12**) – Your testimony becomes undeniable.

How to **Activate This Promise**:

1. Obey in Tithing – Give God the first 10% faithfully.
2. *Give with the Right Heart* – Not grudgingly (**2 Cor. 9:7**).
3. Expect God’s Overflow – **Stand on His Word**.

Prayer for Malachi 3:10 Blessing:

“Father, I bring my tithes and offerings in faith, knowing You are my Provider. Just as You promised in Malachi 3:10, open the windows of heaven over my life! Rebuke the devourer and pour out a blessing so great that I won’t have room to contain it. Let my obedience release Your supernatural abundance. In Jesus’ name, Amen!”

Tzedakah: Give **generously** Luke 6:38.

7. Chronic Illnesses Deut. 28:27, 35, 60)

Prayer:

“By the stripes of Yeshua, I am healed Isaiah 53:5. I break every curse of infirmity and declare divine health and I rebuke every generational sickness and command my body to align with God’s wholeness.”

Remedy:

Teshuvah: Repent for any sin opening doors to sickness.

Tefillah: Pray for healing James 5:14-15.

Tzedakah: Minister healing to others.

8. Lack of Anointing & Stubborn Blocks , Deut. 28:40)

Prayer:

“Father, I break every curse of dryness and blocked anointing by Yeshuas name, . Let Your oil of joy flow (Psalm 45:7). I decree open heavens over my life and ministry. Every yoke is destroyed by Your anointing (Isaiah 10:27).”

Remedy:

Teshuvah: Repent for quenching the Spirit (1 Thess. 5:19).

Tefillah: Pray for fresh anointing (Acts 1:8).

Tzedakah: Serve in ministry.

9. Mental & Emotional Illness (Deut. 28:34)

Prayer:

"Lord, I break every curse of torment, anxiety, and insanity by Yeshuas name. I receive the sound mind of Christ (2 Tim. 1:7). Let only Your peace guard my heart and mind Phil. 4:7."

Remedy:

Teshuvah: Repent for trauma or soul ties.

Tefillah: Pray for mental wholeness (Isaiah 26:3).

Tzedakah: Counsel others in peace.

10. Stolen & Blocked Destinies (Deut. 28:31)

Prayer:

"Father, in the name of Yeshua I cancel every curse of theft and blocked destiny. I decree restoration of all stolen blessings (Joel 2:25). No more shall the enemy rob me. I recover my divine inheritance in Yeshua's name."

Remedy:

Teshuvah: Repent for any legal rights given to the enemy.

Tefillah: Pray for divine justice (Psalm 35:23).

Tzedakah: Help others recover their losses.

11. No Promotions or Advancement (Deut. 28:43)

Prayer:

"Lord, by Yeshuas name I break every curse of stagnation and demotion and decree divine elevation (Psalm 75:6-7). Let favor and promotion come from You (Psalm 113:7-8) and nullify every plot to keep me down."

Remedy:

Teshuvah: Repent for envy or pride.

Tefillah: Pray for God's timing (Eccl. 3:1).

Tzedakah: Celebrate others' success.

12. Unanswered Prayers (Deut. 28:23)

Prayer:

"Father, in Yeshuas name I break every curse blocking my prayers. Let the heavens open over me (Matt. 3:16). I remove every legal case hindering my petitions (1 John 5:14-15). I decree that my prayers are heard and answered."

Remedy:

Teshuvah: Repent for any unconfessed sin (Psalm 66:18).

Tefillah: Pray in alignment with God's will (1 John 5:14).

Tzedakah: Intercede for others.

Final Decree:

CENTRAL PRAYER

"By the blood of Yeshua, I am redeemed from every curse (Gal. 3:13). I stand justified in the Courts of Heaven. Every legal right of the enemy is revoked. I walk in divine blessing, favor, and breakthrough. Amen!"

Key Scriptures:

Galatians 3:13 – "Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law."

Deuteronomy 28:1-2 – "If you obey, blessings will overtake you."

James 4:7 – "Resist the devil, and he will flee."

Action Steps:

- 1. Repent deeply (Teshuvah).***
- 2. Pray fervently (Tefillah).***
- 3. Give generously (Tzedakah).***
- 4. Decree freedom daily.***

***May the Lord break every chain and release His abundant blessings over your life!

HOW TO BREAK FINANCIAL CURSES (BIBLICAL STRATEGY)

Financial curses manifest as chronic debt, sudden losses, business failures, stolen blessings, or unexplained lack—even when you work hard. Here's how to break them spiritually and practically using Scripture.

1. IDENTIFY THE ROOT - Why the Curse Exists

Financial curses often come from:

Generational sins (Exodus 20:5; Deut. 28:15-68)

Personal disobedience Malachi 3:8-9 – robbing God of tithes)

Word curses Proverbs 18:21 – negative declarations over money)

Witchcraft/Oppression Job 1:10 – Satan attacking finances)

Greed/Idolatry of Money (1 Timothy 6:10 – love of money opens doors)

Prayer:

"Father, reveal any sin, vow, or generational pattern that opened a door to financial curses. I repent and break all agreements with poverty, greed, and theft in Jesus' name!"

2. LEGAL REPENTANCE (Cancel the Enemy's Rights)

Before deliverance, close legal doors through repentance:

For not tithing/giving (Malachi 3:8-10)

For greed, fraud, or dishonest gain (Proverbs 13:11)

For complaining about lack (Philippians 2:14)

For generational idolatry (Exodus 34:7)

Prayer:

"Lord, I repent for [name specific sins]. I cancel every legal right the enemy has to my finances. By the blood of Yeshua, I nullify all curses!"

3. BREAK THE CURSE (Spiritual Warfare

4.A. Speak Directly to the Curse:

"In Yeshua's name, I break every financial curse of debt, lack, and theft. I cancel generational poverty, failed businesses, and stolen blessings. I declare Galatians 3:13 —Christ redeemed me from every curse!"

B. Rebuke the Devourer:

"I rebuke the spirit of the devourer (Malachi 3:11 — no more stolen money, sudden expenses, or wasted resources! My finances are blessed and protected."

C. Break Soul Ties with Poverty:

"I sever all unhealthy ties to people, places, or systems that drain me financially. I release God's abundance instead!"

4. RESTORE Yah'S BLESSING - Activate Prosperity

5.A. Start Tithing Faithfully (Malachi 3:10-12)

Give 10% first (Proverbs 3:9-10).

Test God —expect open heavens!

B. Sow Generously (2 Corinthians 9:6-8)

Give offerings beyond tithes to break lack.

Sow into kingdom work (Luke 6:38).

C. Declare Yah's Promises Daily:

The Lord is my Shepherd; I shall not want" Psalm 23:1).

"I lend and do not borrow" Deuteronomy 28:12.

PRACTICAL STEPS FOR FINANCIAL FREEDOM

1. Budget & Eliminate Debt (Proverbs 22:7).

2. Avoid Get-Rich-Quick Traps (Proverbs 13:11).

3. Work Diligently (Colossians 3:23).

4. Seek Godly Counsel (Proverbs 15:22).

PRAYER FOR FINANCIAL BREAKTHROUGH

"Father, I stand on Your Word! I break every curse of lack and declare Your abundance over my life. I tithe and sow in faith, knowing You will open heaven's

windows. Rebuke the devourer and let my finances glorify You! In Yeshua's glorious name, Amen!"

Key Verse: Christ Yeshua redeemed us from the curse of the law... that the blessing of Abraham might come upon us" Galatians 3:13-14.

Next Step: Begin tithing today—even if it's small—and watch God move!
