TEN VERSES ESTABLISH FAITH AND TRUST — FOUNDATIONAL

1. **הַנֶּה עֹפֶלֶת לְאִישָׁרָה נְפִשּׁוּ בָּו, וְצִדְיקָ בְּאָמֹנוֹתָו יִחְיֶה:** Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: but the just/saint shall live by his faith. **Habakkuk 2:4**

2. **הַצֹּר תְּמִימִם פָּעֵלוֹ כִּי כָל דְּרָכָיו מִשְׁפָט אֶל אָמֹנוֹתָו וְאֵין עַוְלָץְדִּיק וְיִשְׁר הָוָא:** He is the Rock, his work is perfect: for all his ways are judgment/righteous: a God of truth and without iniquity, just and right is he. **Deuteronomy 32:4**

3. **מִשְׁפְּכֵל לְאִיתּוֹ הַאֲזֹרְחִי חָסְדֵי יְהָוָה עַולְם אֲשִׁירָה לְזָר וְזָר אָזְדִּיע אָמֹנוֹתָך בְּפִי:** I will sing of the mercies of the LORD for ever: with my mouth will I make known thy faithfulness to all generations. **Psalm 89:1**

4. **וְהִיא אָמֹנוֹת עֲתִיק חָסְן יִשְׁעוֹת חִכְמָת וְדַעַת יִרְאָת יְהָוָה הִיא אָוָצָרָן:** And salvific-Yeshua wisdom and knowledge shall be the [stability] FAITH of thy times, and strength of salvation: the fear of the LORD is his treasure. **Isaiah 33:6**

5. **בְּטַחְיו בְּיְהָוָה עֲדֵי עַד כִּי בְּיָהָוָה צָר עַזְלָמִים:** Trust ye in the LORD for ever: for in the LORD JEHOVAH is Rock OF eternities [everlasting strength]. **Isaiah 26:4**

6. **בָּרוּךְ הָגָבָר אֲשֶׁר יַבְטַח בְּיְהָוָה וְהִיא יְהָוָה מַבְטָחוֹ:** Blessed is the man that trusteth in the LORD, and whose hope the LORD is [trusting in]. **Jeremiah 17:7**

7. **בְּטַח אֶל יְהָוָה בְּכָל לְבָכָ וְאֶל-בִּינְתָּך אֶל-תַּשְׁעַן:** ... Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding... **Proverbs 3:5**

8. **בְּטַח בְּיְהָוָה וְעַשֵּׂה-טוֹב שְׁכֹן-אָרֶץ וְרַעֲתָה אָמֹנוֹתָך:** Trust in the LORD, and do good; so shalt thou dwell in the land, and verily thou shalt be fed, [faith.] **Psalm 37:3**

9. **בְּאֱלֹהִים אֲהַלְל דִּבְרָו בְּאֱלֹהִים בְּטַחְתִּי לֹא אִירָא מֵה-יָעַשָּׂה בָּשָׂר לִי:** In God I will praise his word, in God I have put my trust; I will not fear what flesh [actions]do unto me. **Psalm 56:4**

10. **וַיַּדְיִ-מְשָׁה כְּבָדִים וַיַּחַחַו-אָבָן וַיִּשְׁמִמוּ תְּחִפָּתוֹ וַיִּשְׁבַּע עַלְיָה וְאֶחָרֶן וַיִּקְרַב בְּיָדָיו מֵהָ אָחָד וְמֵהָ אָחָד וְיִהְיֶה. But Moses' hands were heavy; and they took a stone, and put it under him, and he sat thereon; and Aaron and Hur stayed up his hands, the one on the one side, and the other on the other side; and his hands were [steady] FAITH until the going down of the sun.** **Exodus 17:12**
