GREETINGS FROM TURKEY!

Dear brother/sister,



The land we live in is home to the seven churches mentioned in the Book of Revelation... yet today, millions of people live here without ever knowing Jesus Christ. This is precisely why the Lord has called us to Aydın.

Aydın Kurtuluş Church was born 13 years ago through the faithful efforts of a few foreign brothers and sisters. Since then, many servants have come and gone in the Lord's work. We, Mehmet and Berivan, responded "Yes!" to God's powerful call three years ago, and decided to settle here and put down roots. This city has become our mission field, the place of our calling.

When we began serving here, there were about 20 believers in Aydın. After three years of ministry, there is now a vibrant family of around 50 believers. Every week new people are coming—students, young people, and families—and we are sharing the Gospel with them. We organize summer camps, youth camps, and student ministries. Our goal is not only to grow our local fellowship, but also to become a sending church—a spiritual base that can train disciples and send workers into the nations.



In the last 15 months, we have traveled 45,000 kilometers with our car for evangelism journeys. We live in the very region where the Seven Churches once stood, and where many of the events recorded in Acts took place, beginning with Paul and the apostles. Once these lands were full of churches and believers, but today they are surrendered to darkness. Our vision is to see the Seven Churches rise again and to water this land with revival.





Why a New Building?

Today we face a great obstacle: rent.

Our tithes are not only going toward rent; the rent is so high that our tithes are not enough, and every month we must look for outside support to cover the cost. This is very difficult to sustain. It prevents us from expanding our ministries and limits our vision.

If we have our own building, this burden will be lifted entirely. Our tithes will no longer go to rent but will go directly toward spreading the Gospel, raising disciples, running youth camps, and sending out workers. We will be a church that stands on its own feet and serves with its own resources.

And the Lord has already begun to open doors:



- •. When we started, we had only 30 cents in our account, but we prayed in faith for six months.
- •. Miraculously, through a church we had never contacted, the Lord provided \$120,000, and we purchased a strategic piece of land for our church.
- •. We demolished the old wooden building, our plans are ready, and our building permit is on the way.
- •. Now all we need are the resources to raise this house of God.

Our Vision

- A permanent house of faith in Aydın that will serve as a center for the Gospel
- To see the Seven Churches rise again and churches planted in this land
- A sending church—training and sending workers into the nations
- Raising generations dedicated to Christ through youth and student camps
- A safe refuge for families, children, and young people
- A church that stands on its own feet and serves with its own resources through tithes





A Call for a Sister Church

In our hearts we carry a deep longing: to have a sister church that walks with us in Christ—praying together, serving together, and growing together in the Lord.

A sister church is not only about financial support; it is about standing with us before the Lord in prayer, sending teams from time to time to serve alongside us, and sharing in both our joys and our burdens.

We believe that when brothers and sisters from different nations come together as one body of Christ, the light of the Lord shines more brightly. A sister church that prays, carries the vision with us, and serves for revival in Turkey will bear spiritual fruit not only in Aydın but across the whole nation.


To see you join us in this vision would be a great encouragement to us and a powerful step for God's Kingdom.

Our Need

• Total Budget: \$400,000

• Raised So Far: \$155,000

• Remaining: \$245,000

The construction will take place in two steps. The first step is to complete the columns and walls of the three floors (since we are in an earthquake zone, this must be done consecutively). This phase will take about two months. After that, we will move on to the interior design.

The first step requires \$60,000. We currently have \$30,000, and once we raise the remaining \$30,000, the structural framework will be finished. Our goal is to begin this phase in November 2025.

Every brick added is not just a building—it is a platform for future generations to grow in Christ.

• Cost of One Brick: \$500 (or equivalent)


