#### → Specify the Topic or Niche

Always include the desired theme or niche in your prompt. This helps the AI focus its response and deliver more relevant content.

#### → Use Clear and Simple Language

Avoid jargon, complex terms, and spelling mistakes. The clearer your instructions, the easier it is for the AI to understand and respond accurately.

#### → Provide Context

Adding context is crucial for better results. One effective method is to present yourself as an expert in the chosen niche and in content creation. This signals to the AI that your expectations are high, which often results in more thoughtful and in-depth responses.

#### → Use Role-Based Instructions

Another useful strategy is to tell the AI to "act as [a specific role]." This helps simulate real world scenarios and encourages more immersive, realistic answers.

Be Precise and Detailed

→ The more specific you are, the better the AI can tailor its output. Include clear instructions about your goals, constraints, and expectations. However, keep in mind that overly long or complex prompts can be harder for the AI to handle effectively.

#### → Review and Iterate

After receiving a response, ask the AI to evaluate its own output. You can request its opinion on the strengths and weaknesses of the response, and how it might be improved.

By applying these strategies, you'll significantly increase the quality and relevance of the AI's responses.

Example of a prompt for writing an article on the Big Bang for a scientific journal:

i am a researcher in astrophysics and would like to write a 1,000-word article on the Big Bang for a scientific journal.

the overall instruction



Please act as an experienced and knowledgeable astrophysicist and write the article in a clear and concise manner.

The article should follow a logical structure:

- 1. Begin with an overview of the main theories regarding the origin of the Big Bang.
- 2. Then, explain what followed immediately after the Big Bang and describe the early stages of the universe's evolution.

Make sure the article is accessible to scientifically literate readers but avoid overly technical language. The tone should be professional, informative, and suitable for publication in a scientific review.

# The prompts:

### Viral Content Ideas

Goal: beat creative blocks and generate attention-grabbing, share-worthy formats

# <u>And now? Act:</u>

Prompts aren't magic formulas — they're powerful tools. But reaching your goals takes determination, discipline, and persistence.

Here's a 30-day action plan to help you get started the right way and perform at your best from day one:

## Week 1 - Clarity & Setup

Objective: Know where you're going and set yourself up to win

- Define your niche, tone, and target audience.
- Choose your main platform (TikTok, YouTube Shorts, Reels, etc.)
- Set up your workspace (content calendar, idea tracker, script folder).
- Write down 10 content ideas and produce your first 2–3 videos/posts.
- Focus on publishing over perfection your only goal is to get started.

## Week 2 - Launch & Momentum

Objective: Build confidence, consistency, and early signals

- Publish 3 to 5 pieces of content this week.
- Watch how people respond: views, comments, watch time, saves.
- Start creating a realistic routine (e.g. create 2 days, publish 3 days).
- Experiment with different formats (talking head, tips, storytelling, visuals).

# Week 3 - Efficiency & Content Flow

Objective: Save time and create more with less mental load

- Plan your content 1-2 weeks ahead.
- Batch tasks: write several scripts in one go, then shoot multiple videos in one session.
- Repurpose content: turn a video into a post or a post into a reel.
- Build a small content bank to always have something ready to post.
