Be Precise and Detailed

→ The more specific you are, the better the AI can tailor its output. Include clear instructions about your goals, constraints, and expectations. However, keep in mind that overly long or complex prompts can be harder for the AI to handle effectively.

#### → Review and Iterate

After receiving a response, ask the AI to evaluate its own output. You can request its opinion on the strengths and weaknesses of the response, and how it might be improved.

By applying these strategies, you'll significantly increase the quality and relevance of the AI's responses.

Make sure the article is accessible to scientifically literate readers but avoid overly technical language. The tone should be professional, informative, and suitable for publication in a scientific review.

- Choose ONE business model to focus on (digital products, ecom, freelancing, etc.)
- Create your workspace (Notion, Google Docs, Trello) to organize ideas and execution.
- Set a time block each day for content creation or learning (1h min).

#### Week 2:

- Create your first product/service/content piece, no matter how simple.
- Share it publicly (social media, community, marketplace).
- Focus on speed over perfection: launch > learn > improve.

#### <u>Week 3:</u>

- Post daily on one platform (TikTok, LinkedIn, Threads, etc.)

- Ask for feedback, Iterate fast, Don't take silence as failure it's data.

### Week 4:

- Refine your offer: clearer title, better angle, stronger CTA.
- Add urgency or exclusivity (limited-time bonus, countdown, etc.)
- Experiment with low-risk paid traffic (optional).
- Build your email list or simple funnel to start collecting leads for long-term growth.
