We had 23 children (grades K-4) participate as performers in Canadian Playwright Deborah Solberg's The Nutcracker Jr., and 8 teens (grades 7-12) participate as performance mentors and Backstage Badgers. Growth was evident in many of the children and teens who participated in this program. We observed children growing in speech, vocal projection, musicality, and stage presence. We observed them growing in capacity to focus, wait for their turn, cheer on others, and take personal responsibility for their learning. Our teens developed confidence in their own voices and sharing their stage experience with their young charges. At the theatre, they gained technical skills as they supported with props, sets, costumes, lighting, and even operating the scrim and front curtain. Thank you to Ms. Janelle and all our volunteers!
