#### **Yehiel Curry Elected ELCA Presiding Bishop**

Yehiel Curry, recently elected as the fifth presiding bishop of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA) and the first of African descent, emphasizes the importance of not only naming but embodying the church's vision. He believes leadership should involve shared responsibility and participation, particularly through equipping and supporting lay leaders as congregational structures shift.



Curry's journey into ministry was shaped by his background in social work, teaching, and community engagement. Drawn into the church through Shekinah Chapel and its mentoring program, he discerned a call to ministry despite initial hesitation. He became a mission developer, completed theological education, and eventually served as pastor of Shekinah before being elected bishop of the Metropolitan Chicago Synod in 2019 and chair of the Conference of Bishops in 2024.

Reflecting on his path, Curry credits the church's support for nurturing his call and hopes his presence in leadership inspires others to see themselves represented. He describes himself as a "return on investment," highlighting how church resources and encouragement helped shape his ministry and leadership.

#### **UPGRADING OUR MUSICAL WORSHIP LEGACY**

Over 60 years old, the organ console is in dire need of a major overhaul. Levsen Organ Company submitted a bid to rebuild it and also add a record/play feature.

With a bid just under \$91,000, the congregation voted to have the console rebuilt. Scheduled to start after Easter 2026, we have one year to raise the money.

This requires an aggressive commitment from the congregation. Please prayerfully consider how the pipe organ enhances worship and consider a donation to the Organ Refurbishment Fund. 


