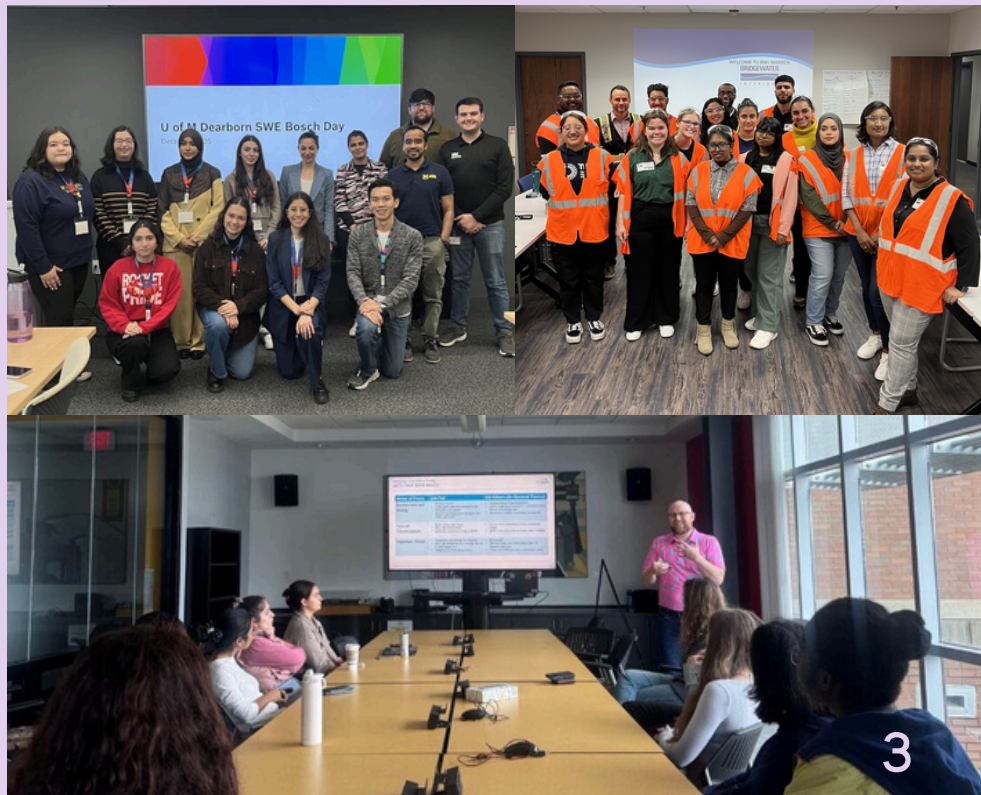
SOCIAL EVENTS

This past year, SWE has hosted STEM outreach at local elementary, middle, and high schools. Exciting engineering and STEM projects were constructed at each school including bristle bots, physics experiences, and penny boat races! The past two years, we have helped host Girl Scouts TechXploration events where young girls explored the different fields in technology and engineering. For the first time this past year, we extending outreach to a Dearborn high school by hosting a “Shadow Day” at which high schoolers shadowed a college student for the day. We also collaborated with a local middle school for a 3-week ongoing bioengineering experiment where kids were able to learn the basics of the scientific method and watch planaria worms grow!
