	a) Bowling Club Presentation: GG circulated a summary of the presentation previously shared						
	with Cllrs and took them through the proposal in detail, explaining the constraints with the						
	current site, particularly the parking and access challenges. He then shared details of the						
	aspirations for the future development of the Bowling Club including the potential benefits of						
	a relocation to the Weirglodd. This would provide members with a safe, sustainable and fully						
	accessible site suitable for members of all ages and abilities. In addition, the new location						
	would improve ease of access for maintenance machinery and other practical benefits gained						
	from being able to operate alongside other successful sports and recreation groups. Cllrs took						
	the opportunity to clarify plans; these are expected to be phased with the initial phase to						
	create the Bowling Green followed at a later date with Clubhouse facilities for drinks, toilets &						
	changing. The Bowling Club will be undertaking further community consultations, in the						
	meantime they requested the Town Council provide:						
	Formal support for the relocation to Y Weirglodd Guidense and planting and a provincious.						
	Guidance on planning and permissions						
	Letters of support for grant applications ON the related CC for the birth the time to the grant be applied to the grant beginning t						
	CW thanked GG for taking the time to share the proposal and confirmed the matter would be						
	considered at the next Council meeting in December. GG then left the Chambers. Cllrs discussed the plans further including consideration of any likely impact on the Allotments. CH						
	asked that this matter be added to the December Meeting. Clerk noted.						
	It was proposed future plans for the Weirglodd site are considered as a whole rather than						
	individual areas and should include parking requirements for all groups. This will be picked up						
	in the future Rugby Club/Weirglodd development discussions. Clerk Noted						
	b) Bryntitli Application from Rhayader Football Club: RT left the meeting. The application for a						
	proportion of the cost to install Solar Panels and Battery Storage was considered against						
	Bryntitli funding criteria and confirmed eligible. Cllrs agreed to support the fund and awarded						
	£1k towards the cost of the project.						
	c) Large Grant Application from Rhayader Football Club: A further application from the Football						
	Club was considered against funding criteria, it was confirmed the application was eligible.						
	After discussion it was agreed to award £3k as a contribution to the cost of the project to						
	allow for the inclusion of Battery Storage. The Football Club will fund the remaining amount.
