1. General provisions

1.1. Battery APL is a motorcycle trip that takes place on public roads, forest roads, gravel roads, field roads and other legally used routes.

1.2. All participants must comply with the Road Traffic Rules of the Republic of Lithuania (KET), the applicable legal acts and these provisions.

1.3. Each participant participates in the event at his/her own risk and is responsible for his/her actions, the technical condition and safety of the motorcycle throughout the event.

1.4. The organizers provide the route in GPX format, but cannot guarantee that the condition of the route will remain unchanged from the moment of its preparation.

1.5. By registering for the event, the participant confirms that he/she is familiar with these regulations and undertakes to comply with them.

2. Driving on the GPX route

2.1. The main principle of the event is to complete the route by driving the GPX route provided by the organizers.

2.2. The participant must drive on the trajectory indicated in the GPX route and may not arbitrarily change the direction of travel or the logic of the route.

2.3. In case of encountering an obstacle on the route, the participant must follow the logic of the route.

2.4. If it is not possible to overcome the obstacle directly, it is recommended to bypass the obstacle only through the left side of the GPX route (to the depth of the territory of Lithuania) if these obstacles occur in the border area with Latvia and Poland.

2.6. **Specifics of border sections:** in the sections of Belarus and Kaliningrad **it is STRICTLY FORBIDDEN** to deviate to the right from the GPX route, participant has to keep on track or if there is no other way tackle obstacle by moving LEFT from the track (deviate – i.e. change the road to the one on the right, drive from the road to the right side forest, enter

the trail-marking area, etc.), GPS interference is likely and possible, offline maps are recommended.

3. Safety on the track

3.1. The entire route of Battery APL takes place in an open environment and the roads are not closed to other traffic.

3.2. Participants may meet vehicles, pedestrians, animals, Border patrol (VSAT) officers and other legal road or infrastructure users, domestic and wild animals.

3.3. The participant must choose a safe speed.

3.4. Oncoming traffic must be expected in border sections and places with limited visibility.

3.5. If there is a doubt between speed and safety, safety is chosen.

4. Peculiarities of the border section

4.1. Participants must comply with all lawful instructions of the officials of the Border patrol (VSAT) and other institutions.

4.2. At the request of officials, documents must be provided (referred to in point 5.5).

4.3. It is prohibited to interfere with the work of officials.

5. Participant's Responsibility

5.1. The Participant confirms that he/she has the right to drive the vehicle, it is technically in good condition and insured.

5.2. The Participant shall be liable for his/her actions, traffic violations and damages.

5.3. In the event of a breakdown of the vehicle, the participant is responsible for repairs, transportation and evacuation.

5.4. The team leader is not a representative of the organizer and his recommendations are not considered as instructions of the organizer.

5.5. The Participant must have with him/her an identity document, driver's license, registration certificate and insurance documents, as well as a participant's card issued by the Organizer.

5.6. Upon noticing an accident, the participant must assess the situation, ensure his safety and then, as far as possible, provide first aid if necessary, and in a more serious case, contact the special services with a request for help by calling 112.

6. Organizer's Responsibility

6.1. The Organizer shall prepare and coordinate the route with the necessary authorities.

6.2. The Organiser shall provide accommodation and sanitary facilities.

6.3. The Organiser shall provide the catering provided for in the programme.

6.4. The Organiser transports one piece of Participant's luggage up to 15 kg and 60 litres.

6.5. The Organiser has the right to change the route due to safety, weather conditions or institutional requirements.

7. Rules of conduct

7.1. Drunk driving is prohibited.

7.2. Violent, aggressive or inadequate behaviour is not tolerated.

7.3. It is not allowed to make noise and disturb other holidaymakers in campsites, camping quiet hours are from 22:00 in the evening to 07:00 am. morning.

7.4. Failure to comply with the above rules may result in the Organizer removing the participant from the event.

8. Participation of minors

8.1. Minors may participate only with a responsible adult.

8.2. The responsible person assumes full responsibility for the minor.

8.3. The responsible person submits a written request to the Organizer, where he/she assumes full responsibility for the minor.

9. Environmental protection

9.1. Littering and destruction of nature is prohibited.

9.2. Participants must respect the local population, the environment and private property.

10. Photography, filming and personal data

10.1. By purchasing a ticket, the participant agrees to be photographed and filmed.

10.2. The material may be used for communication and advertising purposes for an unlimited period of time.

11. Ticket Refund Procedure

11.1. The registration fee is refunded at 50% if the application is submitted before 14/02/2026.

11.2. After this date, the registration fee is non-refundable.

11.3. If the Organizer changes the date of the event, a full refund may be applied.

11.4. In cases of force majeure, the Organiser has the right to postpone the event.

12. Final provisions

12.1. Battery APL is not a race.

12.2. Participants must respect other road users, nature and the community.

12.3. By registering, the participant confirms that he/she has read the regulations and will comply with them.
