The 1st International Joint Seminar on Education and Social Issues (IJSESI) in collaboration with Centre of Pedagogical Research and Innovation (CPRI)

B. Background

The rapid evolution of technology over the past few decades has significantly transformed various aspects of society, with education being one of the most affected domains. The digital society, characterized by the pervasive use of the internet and digital tools, has reshaped how knowledge is disseminated, accessed, and engaged with.

Historically, education was largely confined to physical classrooms, textbooks, and face-to-face interactions. The rise of the internet in the late 20th century marked the beginning of significant changes, as online resources and e-learning platforms emerged, providing new avenues for knowledge acquisition. The advent of social media and mobile technology further accelerated this transformation, allowing learners to access information anytime and anywhere. There are 5 key drivers of change, first, **Technology Integration**: The integration of digital tools in the classroom, such as interactive whiteboards, tablets, and online learning management systems, has created dynamic learning environments. These tools facilitate personalized learning experiences and foster collaboration among students. Second, **Access to Information**: The internet has democratized access to information, enabling learners from diverse backgrounds to tap into a wealth of resources beyond traditional textbooks. Open educational resources (OER) and massive open online courses (MOOCs) have broadened educational opportunities globally.

Third, **Shift in Pedagogy**: Educators are increasingly adopting student-centered teaching approaches that emphasize critical thinking, creativity, and problem-solving over rote memorization. Digital tools support these methodologies by enabling interactive and experiential learning. And Fourth, **Global Connectivity**: Digital platforms allow for global collaboration, enabling students to connect with peers and experts from around the world. This exposure fosters cross-cultural understanding and prepares students for a globalized workforce. The last is **Lifelong Learning**: The digital society has instigated a shift toward lifelong learning, where individuals continuously update their skills and knowledge through online courses and professional development programs. This adaptability is essential in a rapidly changing job market.

Despite the advantages, the transformation of education in a digital society also presents challenges. Issues such as the digital divide, where access to technology is unequal, can exacerbate existing educational inequalities. Additionally, concerns around data privacy, the quality of online content, and the need for digital literacy skills are critical considerations for educators and policymakers. In addition, a major challenge faced in the transformation of education in the digital era is how to elaborate on cognitive, affective, and psychomotor skills. Technology also impacts the dynamics of moral values that influence individual mindsets and attitudes, resulting in a technological paradox that has two sides: as a challenge and an opportunity.

The transformation of education in a digital society is an ongoing process that presents both opportunities and challenges. As technology continues to evolve, it is essential for educators,

learners, and stakeholders to embrace innovative practices while addressing the complexities that arise. This journey towards a more inclusive and effective educational landscape holds the potential to redefine how knowledge is created, shared, and valued in the 21st century.

C. Objectives

The primary objectives of the seminar are to:

- 1. Analyze the impact of digital tehynology on educational practices and learner outcomes.
- 2. Share best practices and innovative approaches to digital education.
- 3. Discuss challenges and barriers to effective digital transformation in education.
- 4. Foster collaboration and partnerships among stakeholders in education technology.

D. Themes

The Transformation of Education in Digital Society

The seminar will focus on transformation of education in digital society, but is not limited to those scope, the following themes:

- 1. Pedagogical Innovations and Best Practices in Education
- 2. Moral Value in Digital Transformation
- 3. Paradox Technology in Teaching and Learning

E. Format

The seminar will be held in a format:

1. Opening Ceremony

This activity is the official opening session of the event by the organizing committee and the institution's leadership. All speakers and participants are expected to attend this session.

2. Plenary Session

The Plenary Session is a time for 12 speakers to present their ideas, thoughts, and standing position, each within a 10-minute timeframe, according to their respective topics. Speakers can present their thoughts directly or through a video that will be played during the plenary session. This session will be guided by a moderator, but there will be no direct Q&A with the participants. Questions and answers will be conducted through an app displayed during the event, and responses will be published on the website in text format. This time consist of 2 plenary sessions, which are plenary session 1 and plenary session 2 (see more details for each plenary session in the rundown below).

3. Parallel Session

The parallel session is an activity where each registered presenter has the opportunity to present their paper. This session will be divided into several breakout rooms based on topics, with each room containing 4-5 presenters. Each room will be guided by a moderator and supported by a facilitator. A Q&A session will also take place during this session.


