Please choose from one of the following essay topics. Submitted essays should not exceed 500 words in length.

1. It is estimated that 12.3 million people in the United States participate in saltwater fishing. Tell us about your experience in saltwater fishing and its impact on your life.
2. On Long Island we are experiencing a shortage of many of the fish targeted by recreational saltwater anglers. Striped bass and bluefish are now overfished and there are real concerns about the long-term health of these fish and others and the impact that it may cause on recreational anglers and local economies. Tell us about your observations of fishing today and the actions that you see that could help in creating abundant fisheries.
3. While we recognize that many people enjoy taking home a fish for the table, effective catch and release practices are an important component for ensuring healthy fisheries. Tell us about your personal efforts to ensure healthy fisheries and suggestions on ways to educate the public on being responsible anglers and good stewards of the resource.
