

The NEET 2024 exam date is May 5, 2024. The NEET application form 2024 process started on February 9, 2024. The last date for NEET 2024 registration is March 9, 2024, and the application fee has to be paid by 11.50 PM on the same date. No other **NEET 2024 dates**, except application, exam and result date have been announced yet. The official website address of NEET 2024 has been changed to neet.ntaonline.in or exams.nta.ac.in/NEET.

Although originally NEET 2024 was slated to be held only in India, later NTA announced that NEET 2024 will be conducted in 14 cities outside India. Hence, the total number of NEET exam cities is 568, which is approximately 14 per cent higher than last year. Registered candidates can change their exam city to any preferred international city during the application correction window and pay the requisite application fee. Foreign candidates who will be registering afresh can select their preferred country and city from the drop-down menu of the NEET 2024 application form and pay the application fee, which is INR 9,500, based on last year's fee.

According to the NEET 2024 applicants, the official website of the exam is affected by technical glitches. Candidates are facing difficulty in logging in to the NEET 2024 website and completing the application and NEET form fee payment process. Moreover, the NTA **NEET Helpline Number**

and email are also unresponsive, adding woes to candidates' distressed situation. Candidates have taken to multiple social media platforms to share their angst.

NTA has responded to this situation by mailing candidates the advisory on payment and application. Moreover, NTA has also released an advisory regarding candidates' Aadhaar Number, stating candidates to re-verify their Aadhaar details, and use their own Aadhaar Card numbers to avoid data mismatch. The exam authority has also disabled the login process through the Aadhaar Number.
