We are a dynamic, multidisciplinary and intercultural team of artists, creative practitioners and youth mentors from South Africa, Iran, Malaysia, Nigeria, USA and Northern Ireland, supported by assistants primarily from India. We invite 4 schools/youth organisations to engage an artist facilitator / art teacher with a group of 12 young people (8 - 17 yrs) from your community to be supported by our team of visual artists, writers, poets, actors, musicians and videographers to take youth-led, arts-based, civic action at the Peter Froggatt Centre.

Artist Facilitators / Art Teachers will be paid £150 per day for their involvement in participant registration, supervision, coordination, small group facilitation and documentation. Schools/organisations or parents must take full responsibility and cover costs for travel supervision, packed lunch/snacks and drinks. Venue and equipment is provided by Queen's University Belfast with eduSOIL delivering programme materials and facilitation.
