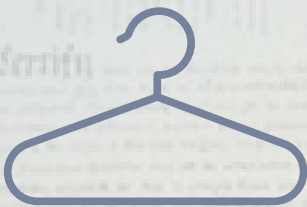

United Nations Human Rights Council

The UNHRC is responsible for the promotion and protection of human rights across the world. It is often called into session to address violations that affect civilians in war zones, refugee camps, and authoritarian states.

In this committee, delegates will be expected to propose international frameworks, advocate for victims, and challenge the positions of powerful states. Diplomacy, law, and empathy all come together here.

All India Political Parties Meet

The AIPPM is a simulation of Indian political decision-making. Delegates step into the roles of leaders from India's political parties, debating national crises, proposing bills, and defending party lines.

This committee will demand sharp rebuttals, strategic alliances, and knowledge of India's current affairs and constitutional structure. Speeches are short. Pressure is high. The margin for error is low.

If you want to lead with voice and logic, this is your arena.

Strategic Council on Emerging Political Blocs

SCEPB is Devshala MUN's flagship original committee. This is not a United Nations body. It is a simulation of high-level global diplomacy between blocs like BRICS+, QUAD, G7, ASEAN, and others.

Delegates will represent blocs and power alliances instead of single countries. They will debate strategy, foreign policy, military alignments, and long-term influence.

This is the committee where realpolitik replaces rhetoric. If you want something fresh, high-level, and rooted in real power dynamics, SCEPB is the committee for you.
