SCHOOL POLICY

- Short-term Enrollment: We warmly welcome families to experience Montessori education for shorter periods (minimum 3 months). Our 3-week Summer Camp runs June-July for families not yet enrolled.
- Monthly & Term Payment: Tuition is due on the 1st of each month, VAT will be added.
- Morning Arrival: Please bring your child between 8:00-8:20am. This is our busiest time, if you are running late, please let us know and be patient as teachers may not answer the door immediately.
- Commitment to Community: We ask families to honor our school calendar. Daily attendance helps your child feel a part of the community—please plan family trips during our scheduled breaks.
- When Your Child is Unwell: Please call or message us by 8:15 at 080-574-4384. If your child was ill the night before but seem better, please share those symptoms with us so we can continue monitoring their wellbeing.
- Pick-up Changes: Please message or call in advance if someone different will collect your child. They'll need to bring ID.
- Medication: All medicines must be in original packaging. Teachers will not administer first doses of any medication.
- Belongings: Please label everything with your child's name—school is not responsible for unlabeled items.
- Parent Handbook: Please read this carefully before enrollment (available on our website).
- Emergency Contact: For late arrivals due to traffic or unexpected situations, please contact us as soon as possible.
