- [] Complete My Preferences Worksheet: I have filled out my "Residential Aged Care Preferences Template" with my final choices and reasons.
- [] **Share My Plan:** I have given a copy of my completed worksheet to my Enduring Guardian, my Attorney, and my close family members.
- [] Store My Documents: I have stored my worksheet in a safe place with my Will and other important planning documents.
- [] Inform My Executor: I have told my Executor where to find all my planning documents.
