

Hyperion-powered Tata Sierra sets new fuel efficiency record

Chennai, Dec 13: Tata Motors Passenger Vehicles' (TMPV) latest offering, the Tata Sierra, has entered the India Book of Records for achieving the highest fuel efficiency in a 12-hour run. During a certified test at NATRAX, Indore, the Sierra delivered an impressive 29.9 km per litre, surpassing the earlier national benchmark.

The record attempt was carried out by the Pixel Motion team, which drove the 1.5-litre Hyperion petrol-powered Sierra continuously from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. on November 30, 2025, with only brief stoppages for driver changes. The achievement was officially validated on the same day.

The milestone highlights the capabilities of Tata Motors' all-new 1.5-litre Hyperion petrol engine, designed to offer high efficiency without compromising on performance, refinement or drivability. Its advanced combustion technology, torque-rich performance band and friction-optimised design ensured

consistent fuel delivery and stable performance throughout the endurance run.

Commenting on the achievement, Mohan Savarkar, Chief Product Officer, Tata Motors Passenger Vehicles, said setting a national efficiency record so early

in the Sierra's lifecycle was a proud moment for the company. He added that the Hyperion engine platform was developed to push the limits of petrol powertrains, and the record reinforces the Sierra's value proposition while underscoring TMPV's focus on advanced and

future-ready technologies.

In a parallel test at NATRAX, the Tata Sierra also clocked a top speed of 222 kmph under specified conditions, further demonstrating the performance potential of the Hyperion engine.

Hydrogen fuel cell passenger vessel launched

Chennai, Dec 13: India took a major step towards green maritime transport as Union Minister for Ports, Shipping and Waterways Sarbananda Sonowal flagged off the commercial operations of the country's first fully indigenous hydrogen fuel cell passenger vessel at Namoo Ghat.

The vessel, powered by an indigenous low-temperature Proton

Exchange Membrane fuel cell system, converts hydrogen into electricity with water as the only byproduct. Built by Cochin Shipyard Ltd and owned by the Inland Waterways Authority of India, it has entered service after successful trials, aligning with India's net-zero target for 2070.

Designed as a 24-metre catamaran for urban transport, the boat can

carry 50 passengers, operates at a service speed of 6.5 knots, and uses a hybrid system combining hydrogen fuel cells, batteries and solar power for up to eight hours of operation. The vessel is certified by the Indian Register of Shipping and marks a key milestone under Maritime India Vision 2030 and Maritime Amrit Kaal Vision 2047.

'Labour codes enhance social security coverage'

Chennai, Dec 13: According to 'Decoding India's New Labour Codes 2025', a new report on the India's recently revised labour code by Brickwork Ratings, the reforms usher in a modern era for the Indian workforce.

The four unified Labour Codes, effective November 21, 2025, consolidate 29 prior acts into streamlined frameworks on wages, industrial relations, social security, and occupational safety. The Code on Wages, 2019 introduces uni-

versal minimum and floor wages, mandates gender-equal pay, and overtime at 2x rate. The Industrial Relations Code, 2020 raises re-trenchment/layoff threshold to 300 workers, up from 100, recognizes fixed-term employment, re-skilling fund, work-from-home, and 60-day strike notice. The Code on Social Security, 2020 extends EPFO/ESI/gratuity to gig/platform workers. Further benefits of the code include fixed-term gratuity after 1 year, and unorganized sector coverage. Finally, the OSHWC Code, 2020-short

for 'Occupational Safety, Health & Working Conditions-standardizes safety for women/migrants, mandates health check-ups for workers over 40, and single PAN-India registration for employees at the time of employment.

"These reforms balance worker welfare with investment-friendly policies, positioning India for inclusive growth," says K.H. Patnaik, Chief Ratings Officer, Brickwork Ratings.

FRND unveils Year in Conversations study

Chennai, Dec 13: FRND, Interact Group's avatar-based audio social platform, has released its Year in Conversations 2025 study, highlighting Bharat's evolving digital behaviour. The report shows that 92% of engagement now comes from Tier 2 and 3 regions, signalling a strong shift towards smaller towns driving meaningful online friendships.

Users across the country actively engaged in voice-led and weekend video conversations, with Hyderabad, Bengaluru and Chennai emerging as the most active cities, while Andhra Pradesh users spent the longest time on conversations. In 2025, users logged over 285 million conversations and 418 million minutes on the app, with Telangana, Tamil Nadu, Karnataka,

Kerala and Maharashtra leading engagement.

Growth was largely fuelled by non-metro regions, accounting for 95% of new users. Virtual gifting surged with 974 million gifts exchanged, while weekends and festivals such as Diwali saw peak usage, including a record 4.04 lakh video conversations in a single day.
